AMC 28.40.010 C. The names of all candidates for the same office shall be on one ballot with spaces for write-ins equal to the number of offices to be filled. For each election, the clerk shall determine the random alphabetical order in which the candidates' last names are placed on the ballot, regardless of the office sought, by conducting a chance selection of each letter of the alphabet. The sequence in which letters of the alphabet are drawn shall be the sequence of letters utilized in establishing the order in which the candidates' last names appear on the ballot. The title of the office and "Vote for no more than (the number of offices to be filled)" shall appear before the names.
