<p>Shall the City of Anchorage, Alaska, incur indebtedness and issue general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000) for the purpose of the construction and equipment of dock, causeway, pier and terminal facilities to extend and add onto the existing Port facilities of the City of Anchorage. Issuance of the bonds shall be contingent on receipt of a grant from the Federal Economic Development Administration, or other federal or state agency, to defray all or part of the costs of the referenced port improvements and equipment, and shall qualify the City for the grant. All said general obligation bonds shall mature within thirty (30) years from the date of issue and shall bear interest at a rate not to exceed eight percent (8%) per annum.</p>

<p>Shall the City of Anchorage, Alaska incur indebtedness and issue General Obligation Bonds in the amount of One Million Two Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$1,220,000) for the purpose of implementing capital improvement program for land acquisition, design, engineering, construction and landscaping of additional Historical and Fine Arts Museum facilities through additions to or enlargement of the existing facilities. All said General Obligation Bonds shall mature within thirty (30) years and bear interest at a rate not to exceed eight percent (8%) per annum.</p>

All said General Obligation Bonds shall mature within Thirty (30) years from the dates of issue and bear interest at a rate not to exceed eight percent (8%) per annum.</p>

<p>Shall the City of Anchorage, Alaska, incur indebtedness and issue Telephone System Revenue Bonds in an amount not to exceed Eleven Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$11,500,000) for the following purposes: Construction of all necessary buildings and additions to buildings and purchase all necessary equipment, appliances, fixtures and all other appurtenances; modifying, improving and extending the present telephone system and plant inside and outside the City and otherwise doing all that is necessary to expand, improve and extend the City-owned telephone system. All said telephone system revenue bonds shall mature within a period not to exceed thirty (30) years from the date of issue and shall bear interest at a rate of not to exceed eight and one-half percentum (8½%) per annum and shall be payable solely from the unpledged revenues derived from the operations of the telephone system of the City of Anchorage.</p>
