### PROPOSITION NO. 1 (Site Acquisition and Construction of Off-Street Parking Facilities)

Shall the City of Anchorage, Alaska, incur indebtedness and issue its general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$6,000,000 for the purpose of providing for the acquisition of sites for and construction of off-street parking facilities and related capital improvements and to pledge all or any part of the city's net revenues from parking meters and parking spaces as additional security for the payment of principal and interest on the bonds. Said bonds shall mature within 30 years of the date of issue and bear interest at a rate not to exceed 8% per annum.

### PROPOSITION NO. 2 (Parks and Recreation Improvements)

Shall the City of Anchorage, Alaska, incur indebtedness and issue its general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$4,100,000 for the purpose of implementing a capital improvements program of the Parks and Recreation Department, which program consists of general improvement and upgrading of various park areas, improvement, modification and additions to existing park facilities, construction of new park facilities, and acquisition of land for further park development, as more specifically provided in Section 1 of Resolution No. 43-R-74. All said general obligation bonds shall mature within 30 years from the date of issue and bear interest at a rate not to exceed eight percent (8%) per annum.

All of these general

Shall the City of Anchorage, Alaska, incur indebtedness and issue Water System Revenue Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$11,000,000 for the purpose of constructing all necessary buildings and additions to buildings, purchasing all necessary equipment, appliances, fixtures and all other appurtenances and to otherwise do all that is necessary to expand, improve and extend the city-owned water system as more specifically provided for in Resolution 40-R-74. All of said Water System Revenue Bonds shall mature within a period not to exceed 30 years from the date of issue, shall bear interest at a rate of not to exceed 8-1/2% per annum and shall be payable solely from the unpledged revenues derived from the operations of the water system of the City of Anchorage.
