WHEREAS, the Municipality seeks to submit to HUD the 2024 Action Plan, which is
year two of five annual action plans included in the 2023-2027 Housing and Community
Development Consolidated Plan (Consolidated Plan), identifying the activities to be
undertaken with CDBG, HOME, and ESG funds based on the actual grant allocations
received from HUD for the 2024 Program Year (PY); and,

WHEREAS, the 2024 Action Plan appropriates CDBG entitlement funds in the amount not to exceed \$1,877,033, when tendered; and

WHEREAS, the 2024 Action Plan appropriates HOME entitlement funds in the amount not to exceed \$635,505, and HOME program income not to exceed \$25,500, when tendered; and

31 **WHEREAS,** the 2024 Action Plan appropriates ESG entitlement funds in the amount 32 not to exceed \$164,572, when tendered; and,

WHEREAS, projects funded or expanded through the HUD entitlement grants are consistent with the goals set forth in the Consolidated Plan for homeless services, affordable housing, and suitable living environments and comply with federal regulations. CDBG activities are subject to 24 CFR 570, HOME activities are subject to 24 CFR 92, and ESG activities are authorized under Subtitle B of Title IV, McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act 24 CFR 576.

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- NOW THEREFORE, THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:
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Section 1. The Assembly hereby adopts the 2024 Action Plan, year two of five of the 1 HUD Consolidated Plan, to address housing and community development needs of 2 lower-income persons and individuals and families experiencing homelessness through 3 application to HUD for CDBG, HOME, and ESG grants. 4 5 Section 2. The Assembly hereby appropriates the PY 2024 CDBG entitlement funds 6 in the amount not to exceed ONE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN 7 THOUSAND THIRTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$1,877,033), when tendered, to the 8 Anchorage Health Department, Federal Grants Fund (241900). 9 10 **Section 3.** The Assembly hereby appropriates the PY 2024 HOME entitlement funds 11 in the amount not to exceed SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND FIVE 12 HUNDRED FIVE DOLLARS (\$635,505), when tendered, to the Anchorage Health 13 14 Department, Federal Grants Fund (241900). 15 Section 4. The Assembly hereby appropriates HOME Program Income in the amount 16 not to exceed TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$25.500) to 17 the Anchorage Health Department, Federal Grants Fund (241800). 18 19 20 Section 5. The Assembly appropriates the PY 2024 ESG entitlement funds in the amount not to exceed ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED 21 SEVENTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$164,572), when tendered, to the Anchorage Health 22 Department, Federal Grants Fund (241900). 23 24 **Section 6.** Based on approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly of this resolution, 25 the Anchorage Health Department will execute the grant awards and contract 26 agreements identified in the 2024 Action Plan upon approval by HUD. 27 28 Section 7. A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE (MOA) Subject: HOUSING ADOPTING THE 2024 AND COMMUNITY **DEVELOPMENT ANNUAL ACTION PLAN (2024 ACTION PLAN),** WHICH CONSTITUTES APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG), THE HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS PROGRAM (HOME), AND THE EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT (ESG) AND APPROPRIATES THE 2024 PROGRAM YEAR GRANTS FROM HUD IN THE AMOUNTS NOT TO EXCEED: ONE MILLION EIGHT SEVENTY-SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND THIRTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$1,877,033) IN CDBG ENTITLEMENT, WHEN TENDERED; SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FIVE DOLLARS (\$635,505) IN HOME ENTITLEMENT. WHEN TENDERED; TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$25,500) IN HOME PROGRAM INCOME; AND ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$164,572), WHEN TENDERED, IN ESG ENTITLEMENT, ALL TO THE FEDERAL GRANT FUND (241) FOR THE ANCHORAGE HEALTH DEPARTMENT (AHD).

The purpose of the resolution is to adopt the 2024 Action Plan and Program Year (PY) 2024 HUD entitlement funds and CDBG program income. The 2024 Action Plan is the second year of five annual action plans included in the 2023-2027 Housing and Community Development Consolidated Plan (Consolidated Plan) and constitutes the MOA's application to HUD for entitlement funds.

The 2024 Action Plan outlines the program of activities to be undertaken with CDBG, HOME, and ESG funds. The 2024 Action Plan focuses on addressing the needs of lower-income individuals and families and people experiencing homelessness within the MOA.

The 2024 Action Plan was developed in accordance with HUD and federal regulations. The 2024 program year began on January 1, 2024. The MOA has a deadline of August 16th of this year to submit the Annual Action Plan to HUD as an application for the 2024 entitlement grants. The 2024 Action Plan will be submitted to HUD for review upon the Assembly's
approval. HUD has a review period of up to 45 days after this initial submission.
The 2024 entitlements identified are based on the actual grant allocations received
from HUD.

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Consistent with federal regulations 24 CFR 91.115, a public notice published on July 4, 2024 in the Anchorage Daily News (ADN), a newspaper with statewide distribution, announced the availability of the draft 2024 Action Plan, a public hearing, and a 30-day public comment period. A presentation and public hearing on the 2024 Action Plan were held at 6:00 PM on July 17, 2024, in the Z. J. Loussac Library, Wilda Marston Theater.

Anchorage Health Department requests approval of the attached resolution adopting the 2024 Action Plan. Details on the sources and uses for each of these grants are listed in the project table included in this Assembly Memorandum. More detailed descriptions of each proposed activity are included in the Draft 2024 Action Plan, which was made available on the Municipality's website as of July 1, 2024.

The project table on the next page details the allocation of funds by project or activity. The "To Be Determined" (TBD) funds listed in the table for CDBG funds of \$754,019 and for HOME funds of \$199,221 will be available to fund one or more acquisition projects but projects have yet to be selected for this funding. Anchorage Health Department will propose a substantial amendment to the 2024 Action Plan to the Anchorage Municipal Assembly to appropriate these unallocated 2024 PY CDBG funds.

Upon the approval of the Assembly Resolution by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly and subsequent approval by HUD of the 2024 Action Plan, Anchorage Health Department intends to execute the above grant awards and contracts. Once approved, changes can be made to the 2024 Action Plan through the submission and approval of substantial amendments to the Action Plan by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly and HUD.
