## ANCHORAGE, ALASKA AR No. 2024-\_\_\_\_

A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY CALLING ON OUR STATE LEADERSHIP TO JOIN OTHER STATES IN CALLING ON RESTRICTIONS OF SALES OF UNREGULATED DIET PILLS AND MUSCLE BUILDING SUPPLEMENTS TO YOUTH

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**WHEREAS**, over-the-counter diet pills and muscle-building supplements are common and widely available without restrictions to consumers of all ages, with one in five women and one in 10 men reporting ever using these products<sup>1</sup>; and

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**WHEREAS**, these dietary supplements often claim to promote weight loss or muscle building, but many of these products are sold without any scientific evidence of their safety or effectiveness, and are inadequately regulated by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA)<sup>2</sup>; and

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**WHEREAS**, the lack of regulation of these products has allowed some to end up on retails shelves mislabeled, having unclear dosing recommendations and some are adulterated with prescription pharmaceutical compounds or illegal substances such as steroids. These adulterated products have been tied to significant adverse health effects including gastrointestinal impairment, tachycardia, hypertension, myocardial infarction, stroke and severe liver injury<sup>3</sup>; and

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**WHEREAS**, diet pill use is prospectively linked with a higher risk of eating disorders diagnosis<sup>4</sup> and illicit steroid use<sup>5</sup>; and

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**WHEREAS**, the American Academy of Pediatrics has released two reports strongly cautioning against teens using diet pills<sup>6</sup> and muscle-building supplements<sup>7</sup> for any reason; and
