



- The majority of the District's heavy equipment is > 20 years old
- The District is procuring three dump trucks and a sander this fall; likely arrival is next summer/fall
- The District is leasing additional loaders this year, and has a back-up contract for sanding
- The District is building a snow removal bond for April 2025, to modernize a portion of the fleet

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*** Anchorage School District has 90 facilities; 84 schools and 6 support facilities between Mirror Lake and Girdwood. Our crews work night shifts only. After a snow event the priorities are:

- Initial Clearing of bus lanes, Car drop-offs, and parking lots
- Sanding/gravel as needed
- Snow removal to an MOA approved dump site
