November 5, 2024 v.2

Federal assistance to enable faith communities with excess land to build affordable housing in their communities.

The Need

Nationwide shortage of affordable housing

The Opportunity

- Many faith communities have excess land
- Many are centrally located
- Congregations know local needs

The Challenges

- Traditional commercial financing and economics do not pencil out
- Many faith communities need organizational and financial support

It can be done!

- Examples of success (need several)
- Thomas Center for Senior Leadership (8 years of operation)

Rental Premise

- Recipients agree to equal housing for all
- No discrimination for religion, race, ethnicity or LGBTQ+
