A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PURCHASE AND ACQUISITION OF REAL PROPERTY LEGALLY DESCRIBED AS TRACT LT E-3A, CAMPBELL CREEK COMMERCIAL PARK CURRENTLY OWNED BY TRIPLE A SELF STORAGE FOR FAIR MARKET VALUE FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE MILLION THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,300,000).

WHEREAS, Solid Waste Services is comprised of two separate utilities – the Refuse Collection Utility which collects refuse for disposal and the Disposal Utility which owns a transfer station in Girdwood, the Central Transfer Station in mid-town and the Anchorage Regional Landfill located near Eagle River. The Disposal Utility receives trash at the two transfer stations and hauls the refuse to the Anchorage Regional Landfill for final disposal.

WHEREAS, Property adjacent to the Solid Waste Services Central Transfer Station, legally described as Tract LT E-3A, Campbell Creek Commercial Park currently owned by Triple A Self Storage is for sale: and

WHEREAS, Anchorage Municipal Code sections 25.20.010 and .020 authorize the Municipality to acquire land for any public purpose, upon approval by the Assembly; and

WHEREAS, Solid Waste Services desires to purchase this property on behalf of the Municipality for expansion of the Central Transfer Station; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality seeks authorization to purchase this property for the fair market value for an amount not to exceed Three Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,300,000) plus closing costs, with the funds to come from the approved 2006 Solid Waste Services Disposal Capital Budget (563); now therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

The purchase of Tract LT E-3A, Campbell Creek Commercial Park currently owned by Triple A Self Storage for Three Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,300,000) is hereby authorized.

Within six months of the approval of this Resolution No. 2006-125, the Administration Section 2. shall submit a plan for the use of the property to the Assembly which shall include a plan for the sale of such part of the property which is not needed for expansion of the Central Transfer Station.



Subject: A Resolution Approving the Purchase and Acquisition of Real Property Legally Described as Tract LT E-3A, Campbell Creek Commercial Park currently owned by Triple A Self Storage for fair market value for an Amount Not to Exceed Three Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,300,000).

Solid Waste Services is comprised of two separate utilities – the Refuse Collection Utility which collects refuse for disposal and the Disposal Utility which owns a transfer station in Girdwood, the Central Transfer Station (CTS) in mid-town and the Anchorage Regional Landfill (ARL) located near Eagle River. The Disposal Utility receives trash at the two transfer stations and hauls the refuse to the Anchorage Regional Landfill for final disposal.

The Central Transfer Station was built in 1977 when the Merrill Field and International Airport Road Landfills were closed. The transfer site was established to provide a centralized location for the citizens of Anchorage to dispose of their trash. Originally designed as a shredder plant, the Central Transfer Station was modified in 1982 to the present day tipping floor with a new scale-house and cash-booth added. A warm storage building for the growing Refuse Collections fleet and administrative building were added in 1987. The Household Hazardous Waste Disposal program was established at this time and room for the collection of hazardous waste was also incorporated into the rapidly shrinking space.

The Central Transfer Station tipping floor has deteriorated and life expectancy is less than five years. This year SWS chose to make repairs instead of a complete floor replacement in anticipation of possibly expanding the facility. The SWS employee parking lot is full to capacity and employees often have to park in the aisles. The administrative building, although still functional, is in need of a new HVAC system. High volume traffic into the transfer station occasionally backs up onto public roadways. With the addition of Wal-Mart traffic to the south, SWS anticipates this problem will only grow worse.

As Anchorage grows, the Central Transfer Station must also accommodate additional essential services to the public. The current facility receives approximately 80% of the waste generated in Anchorage and is capable of handling upwards of 1,500 tons of refuse per day. This capability satisfies the near-term capacity requirements for services. Unfortunately, the current site does not have space to accommodate any additional services.

An adjacent lot known as Tract LT E-3A, Campbell Creek Commercial Park currently owned by Triple A Self Storage is available for purchase. With the acquisition of this space, the Central Transfer Station will be able to expand the depth of services to provide more comprehensive waste management to the public. A map is attached to show the current SWS Central Transfer Station land and the adjacent tract we wish to purchase.

With the additional space requested, future modifications could include; re-routing of transfer station traffic to remove truck traffic from 54th and 56th Avenues and Juneau Street, improvements to the transfer station logistics, potential redevelopment of the aging administration building, relocating the household hazardous waste program to a more convenient location and expanding the facility, adapting of the facility to other uses within the waste management field such as an organics diversion program, recycling, and material processing which will better serve the needs of the community.
