AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A REVOCABLE USE PERMIT TO LITTLE BEAR'S PLAYHOUSE, INC., A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION, OF PREMISES LOCATED AT 124 EGLOFF DRIVE IN GIRDWOOD, FOR A DAYCARE CENTER.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) owns land and improvements on a parcel legally described as Tract A-1, Girdwood First Addition Subdivision (Parcel ID #075-062-56) in Girdwood; and

WHEREAS, Little Bear's Playhouse, Inc. currently occupies the improvements and operates it as a daycare center, and desires a Permit of the premises; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Anchorage Municipal Code (AMC) section 25.40.050B., the MOA may "... dispose of municipal land to ... a nonprofit corporation ... for less than the fair market value of the interest disposed of, upon a finding by the assembly that the disposal will allow the use of the land for a public purpose beneficial to the municipality"; and

WHEREAS, the granting of the Permit to Little Bear's Playhouse shall incur no revenue to the Municipality of Anchorage and requires a finding by the Assembly of no substantial value to the Municipality; Now, therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Pursuant to Anchorage Municipal Code section 25.30.040B., the Assembly hereby finds that a Revocable Use Permit with Little Bear's Playhouse, Inc., a non-profit corporation, is a public purpose beneficial to the Municipality.

<u>Section 2.</u> The granting of the Permit to Little Bear's Playhouse is without substantial value to the Municipality.

<u>Section 3.</u> A less than fair market value Permit of the premises to Little Bear's Playhouse is hereby approved.

<u>Section 4.</u> This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Assembly.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A REVOCABLE USE PERMIT TO LITTLE BEAR'S PLAYHOUSE, INC., A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION, OF PREMISES LOCATED AT 124 EGLOFF DRIVE IN GIRDWOOD, FOR A DAYCARE CENTER.

This Ordinance authorizes a Revocable Use Permit between the Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) and Little Bear's Playhouse, Inc. (Little Bear's) for use of the land and premises located at 124 Egloff Drive in Girdwood for less than fair market value, beginning May 1, 2009 and expiring April 30, 2010.

The property and its improvements are owned by Municipality of Anchorage (MOA), and legally described as Tract A-1, Girdwood First Addition Subdivision (Parcel Identification #075-062-56).

The Girdwood Board of Supervisors (GBOS) and the residents of Girdwood have long recognized the need and support for good quality daycare within its community. Records dating back more than 20 years indicate continued support by the MOA for Little Bears Playhouse in its current facility. In an attempt to make daycare more affordable to Girdwood residents, GBOS has supported them in a variety of ways, including a no fee permit for the building.

Little Bear's previously had a use permit with the MOA for the facility, which has expired. Negotiation of the permit is authorized under Anchorage Municipal Code section 25.30.070B.

Material terms of the Permit agreement also include the following:

- 1. Little Bear's Playhouse, Inc. shall receive a rent-free Permit for the term of the permit to continue use of the facility currently being operated as a daycare center.
- 2. Upon mutual agreement of the parties, Little Bear's shall have the option to exercise Five one-year extensions of the Permit, with any additional extension of the Permit subject to all provisions of the Anchorage Municipal Code then in effect, and is not of substantial value to the MOA.
