THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code 12.45.055 is amended by adding a new subsection E to read as follows (the remainder of the section is not affected and therefore not set out):

12.45.055 Security for fiduciary performance.

E. Security for fiduciary performance under this section may be waived for a rental agency having three or fewer motor vehicles for rent provided the rental agency files a tax return and remits the full amount of tax due by the due dates prescribed in this chapter.

Section 2. Anchorage Municipal Code 12.45.160 is amended by adding a new subsection C to read as follows (the remainder of the section is not affected and therefore not set out):

12.45.160 Confidentiality of records.

C. This section shall not prohibit the chief fiscal officer from sharing information obtained from tax returns, documents, records, and/or reports filed with the municipality pursuant to this chapter with any local, state, or federal government agency for the purpose of enforcing this chapter.

PUBLIC SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS: This ordinance will enable proprietors renting three or fewer motor vehicles to reduce their cost of compliance with AMC chapter 12.45. This ordinance will enable such proprietors to complete the process of obtaining a code-required Certificate of Registration from the Municipality without the need to provide a financial guarantee to ensure performance of the rental agency's fiduciary responsibilities under AMC chapter 12.45. The typical business affected by this ordinance is an individual advertising a motor home for rent.

PRIVATE SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS: This ordinance is expected to increase the rate of voluntary compliance with AMC chapter 12.45 by small proprietors. This ordinance will decrease the Finance Department's ability to collect delinquent rental vehicle taxes, penalties, and interest from non-compliant small-proprietor rental agencies, but the dollar amount exposed to risk of loss is projected to be minimal due to the small size of these businesses. This ordinance is expected to enable the Finance Department to increase rental vehicle tax collections by sharing information with the State of Alaska Department of Revenue, obtaining the results of their rental vehicle tax enforcement efforts within the Municipality, and assessing MOA rental vehicle taxes against unregistered rental agencies and/on rental vehicle transactions that were not reported on MOA rental vehicle tax returns.

THE PURPOSE OF ENFORCING THIS CHAPTER

This ordinance will reduce the costs of compliance with AMC chapter 12.45 for proprietors offering three or fewer motor vehicles for rent within the Municipality of Anchorage (MOA). AMC chapter 12.45 requires an applicant for a Certificate of Registration to produce a financial guarantee to complete the registration process. This guarantee ensures the agency will fulfill fiduciary responsibilities of collecting tax from renters and remitting it to MOA. Such a financial guarantee can be difficult and costly to obtain and as such, can be a barrier to entry for proprietors of small businesses. A typical vehicle rental business hindered by this financial guarantee requirement is an individual advertising a personal motor home for rent on a part time basis. Many of these persons want to comply with the code requirement, but are unable to do so.

This ordinance mirrors a similar exclusion, contained in AMC Chapter 12.20, Room Tax, where operators with three or fewer rooms may request waiver of the financial guarantee.

Our experience with the room tax code has shown that risk of exposure to loss by waiving the financial guarantee requirement for small businesses is not significant.

Alaska Statute AS 43.52.010 levies a tax at the State level on the rental of motor vehicles within Alaska and rental agencies operating within the Municipality file quarterly tax returns to both the State and MOA. This ordinance is expected to improve the Finance Department's effectiveness and efficiency in enforcing AMC Chapter 12.45 by allowing the Chief Fiscal Officer to share and exchange information obtained from rental vehicle tax returns and related business records with the State of Alaska Revenue Department and other pertinent government agencies at the local, state, or federal level.
