WHEREAS, GINGER LLC. has made an application with the Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Board and has paid the required fee for the Transfer of Beverage Dispensary Liquor License #4451 and Restaurant Designation Permit, to be used for Ginger, located at 425 W 5th Avenue, Anchorage, Alaska; and



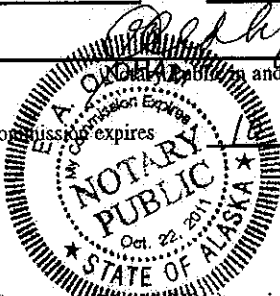

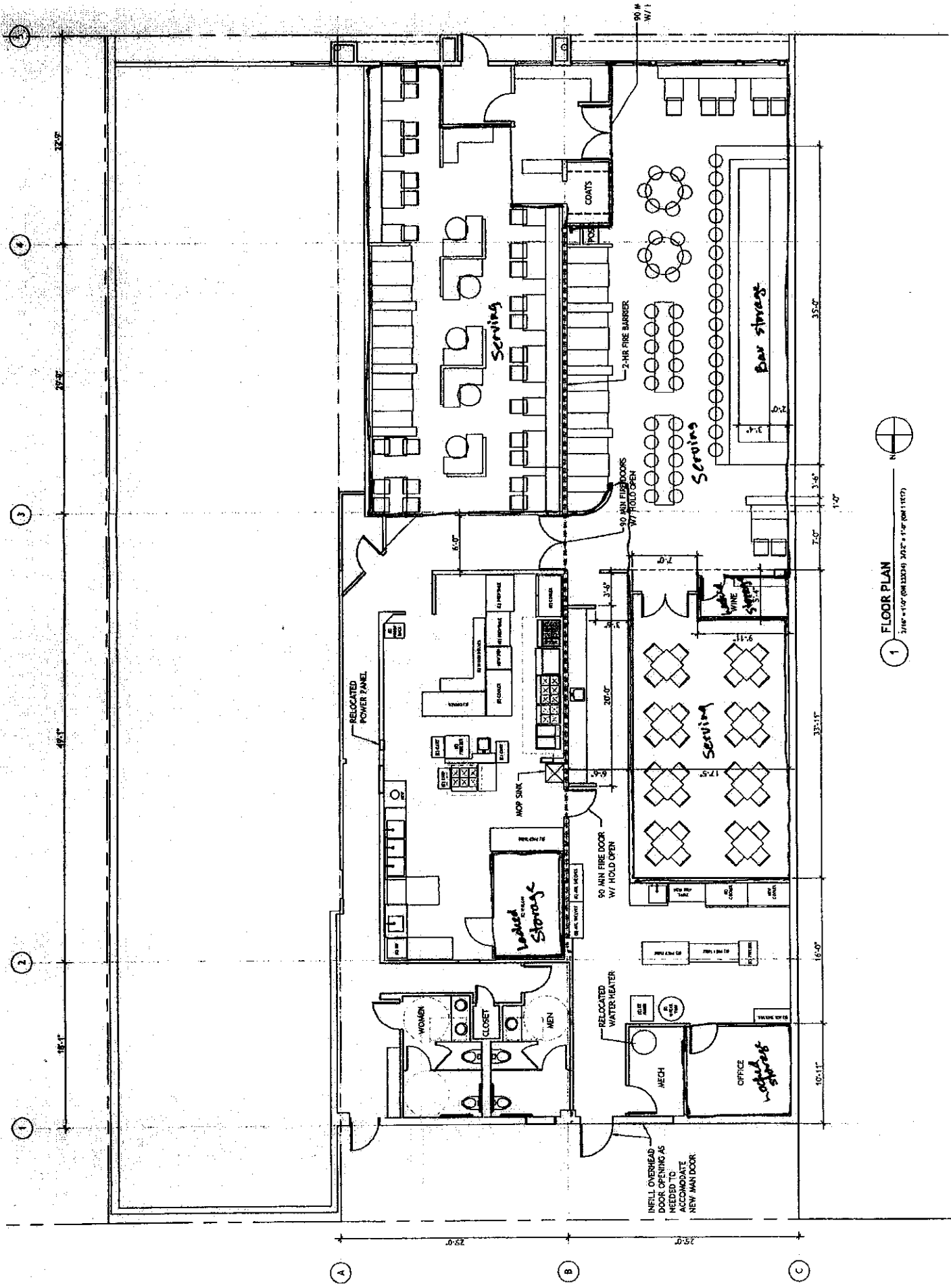

This is a notice to you as licensee that an alleged violation has occurred. If the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board decides to act against your license, under the provisions of AS 44.62.330 - AS 44.62.630 (Administrative Procedures Act) you will receive an Accusation and Notice of your right to an Administrative Hearing.

Note: This is not an accusation or a criminal complaint.

VIOLATION: On 1-8-09, at about 1844 hours, Ginger waitress Lisa Maria Andrus furnished an alcoholic beverage to two persons under the age of 21. Manager Jeremy M. Loyer was asked to provide proof of attending alcohol server training to which he later stated his training had expired about a year ago. He was told to stop serving until he could obtain current certification. Andrus was issued a summons for furnishing alcohol to a person under the age of 21. She was advised an additional charge would be forwarded for serving the other under 21 person. A mandatory court date of 2-2-09, 0830 hours, Anchorage District Court was assigned. The incident occurred during a compliance check. As a reminder, Anchorage Municipal Ordinance requires a person to have alcohol server training prior to starting work.

Your attention is directed to AS 04.16.052(5): Furnishing of alcoholic beverages to persons under the age of 21 by licensees.

A licensee or an agent or employee of the licensee may not with criminal negligence:

(5) while working on a licensed premises, furnish or deliver an alcoholic beverage to a person under the age of 21 years.

Your attention is directed to **AS 04.21.025: Alcohol Servers Education Course**

(a) As a condition of issuance or renewal of a license and selling alcoholic beverages under a license, the board shall require a licensee who sells or serves alcoholic beverages and a licensee's agents and employees who sell or serve alcoholic beverages or check the identification

of a patron to complete an alcohol server education course approved by the board, if the license is for a

- (1) beverage dispensary;
- (2) restaurant or eating place;
- (3) club;
- (4) package store;
- (5) recreational site;
- (6) pub;
- (7) conditional contractor.

(b) The subjects that are included in an approved alcohol server education course shall be determined under regulations adopted by the board. In approving alcohol server education courses, the board shall consider the needs of both urban and rural licensees regarding access to an approved alcohol server education course. A licensee, agent, or employee who sells or serves alcoholic beverages shall keep proof acceptable to the board of successful completion of an approved alcohol server education course on the licensed premises during working hours.

(c) A licensee, agent, or employee shall complete the course required under (a) of this section not more than 30 days after being licensed or employed.

(d) The board shall review an approved alcohol server education course at least once every three years.

(e) A person licensed as a common carrier dispensary shall train agents and employees who sell or serve alcoholic beverages or who check the identification of a patron on provisions of state law regarding sale of alcoholic beverages, including AS 04.16.015 , 04.16.020, 04.16.030, 04.16.051, 04.16.052, 04.16.120, 04.16.125, AS 04.21.030 , and 04.21.050. The training must include the subjects of the effects of alcohol consumption, identifying a drunken person, determining valid identification, intervention to prevent unlawful alcohol consumption, and penalties for unlawful acts by agents and employees of licensees. A common carrier licensee shall, once every three years, provide the board with a description of its training program including the subjects taught, teaching method, and testing required.

You are directed to respond to the Director of the Alcohol Beverage Control Board in writing to this notice of violation within 10 days to explain what action you have taken to prevent a reoccurrence of this violation. **Please include your Alcohol License Number in your response.**

A Response is Required

15 AAC 104.525 (B) provides that upon receipt of a Notice of Violation, a licensee may request to appear before the Director and be heard regarding the Notice of Violation. The request must be made within ten days after receipt of the Notice and the Director must grant an appearance within ten days after receipt of a request.
