1 **A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN ALTERNATIVE ALLOCATION METHOD FOR THE SOA FY10**  
2 **SHARED FISHERIES BUSINESS TAX PROGRAM AND CERTIFYING THAT THIS**  
3 **ALLOCATION METHOD FAIRLY REPRESENTS THE RELATIVE DISTRIBUTION OF**  
4 **SIGNIFICANT EFFECTS OF FISHERIES BUSINESS ACTIVITY IN THE COOK INLET**  
5 **FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AREA**

8 **WHEREAS**, AS 29.60.450 requires that for a municipality to participate in the SOA FY10 Shared Fisheries  
9 Business Tax Program, the municipality must demonstrate to the Department of Commerce, Community, and  
10 Economic Development that the municipality experienced significant effects during calendar year 2008 from  
11 fisheries business activities;  
12

13 **WHEREAS**, 3 AAC 134.060 provides for the allocation of available program funding to eligible  
14 municipalities located within fisheries management areas specified by the Department of Commerce,  
15 Community, and Economic Development;  
16

17 **WHEREAS**, 3 AAC 134.070 provides for the use, at the discretion of the Department of Commerce,  
18 Community, and Economic Development, of alternative allocation methods which may be used within  
19 fisheries management areas if all eligible municipalities within the area agree to use the method, and the  
20 method incorporates some measure of the relative significant effect of fisheries business activity on the  
21 respective municipalities in the area;

23 **WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Anchorage proposes to join all other participating municipalities within the  
24 Cook Inlet Fisheries Management Area in an alternative allocation method for SOA FY10;

26 **WHEREAS**, such alternative allocation shall be fifty percent (50%) divided equally and fifty percent (50%)  
27 divided on a per capita basis.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, The Anchorage Assembly Resolves:



31 **Section 1.** That the alternative allocation method is certified and fairly represents the relative  
32 distribution of significant effects during 2008 of fisheries business activity in the Cook Inlet Fisheries  
33 Management Area.

35 **Section 2.** This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Assembly.

3 **SUBJECT:** A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN ALTERNATIVE ALLOCATION METHOD  
4 FOR THE SOA FY10 SHARED FISHERIES BUSINESS TAX PROGRAM AND  
5 CERTIFYING THAT THIS ALLOCATION METHOD FAIRLY REPRESENTS THE  
6 RELATIVE DISTRIBUTION OF SIGNIFICANT EFFECTS OF FISHERIES BUSINESS  
7 ACTIVITY IN THE COOK INLET FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AREA

9 The Shared Fisheries Business Tax Program was created by the Legislature in 1991. The  
10 program provides for sharing of state fish tax collected outside municipal boundaries with  
11 municipalities that have been affected by fishing industry activities.  
12

13 Anchorage is located in the Cook Inlet Fisheries Management Area. Other municipalities  
14 located in this area are Homer, Kachemak, Kenai, Kenai Peninsula Borough, Seldovia,  
15 Seward and Soldotna. The SOA FY10 program total allocation to be shared within this area  
16 is approximately \$59,641. Anchorage's share is estimated to be \$27,470. The alternative  
17 allocation methodology is: 50% divided equally between all the municipalities applying and  
18 50% divided on a per capita basis.  
19

20 To participate in this program, the municipal governing body is required to approve a  
21 resolution requesting funding using the alternative allocation method.  
22

23 THE ADMINISTRATION RECOMMENDS APPROVAL OF A RESOLUTION ADOPTING  
24 AN ALTERNATIVE ALLOCATION METHOD FOR THE SOA FY10 SHARED FISHERIES  
25 BUSINESS TAX PROGRAM AND CERTIFYING THAT THIS ALLOCATION METHOD  
26 FAIRLY REPRESENTS THE RELATIVE DISTRIBUTION OF SIGNIFICANT EFFECTS OF
