THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.

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The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) has received a grant award from the Alaska Department of Public Safety for up to \$200,000. DHHS and the Anchorage Police Department (APD) are contributing \$8,550, as a non-required matching contribution to cover the Indirect Governmental Cost associated with the grant. The period of the grant is from January 1, 2010 through June 30, 2010.

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The funds for this grant are available for use by any Municipality within the State of Alaska (SOA) through a Federal Office of Violence Against Women grant for Sexual Assault Response Team (SART) Forensic Examinations. These funds will be paid to the Municipality of Anchorage on a cost reimbursable basis.

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Under the terms of the grant, DHHS will verify the billing to the SOA Division of Alaska State Troopers by following specific requires, such as: SART examinations must be authorized by the APD and the billing items of the examination are acceptable for reimbursement. The complete list of acceptable and unacceptable items for reimbursement is listed on the letter from the SOA Division of Alaska State Troopers attached as Appendix A.

Dear Chief of Police;

The Alaska State Troopers (AST) have federal grant funds from the Office on Violence Against Women (OVW) to assist municipal police departments with the payment of the forensic portion of SART exams. These grant funds are limited and will only be available until <u>June 30, 2010 or until the funds have been expended</u>. We want to stress that this is a short term project and as such, you should budget accordingly. To simplify the process we are requesting that your agency pays the hospital or SART program provider directly and then AST will reimburse your agency.

The start date of this project is September <u>15, 2009</u>. AST will accept invoices for bills dated September 15, 2009 and forward. Any bills submitted that are dated prior to September 15, 2009 will be considered non-reimbursable.

The OVW grant will only cover the costs for exams specific to <u>adults</u>. We can not reimburse your agency for exams for minors. Also, as stated above AST will reimburse your agency for items that have been deemed forensic. AST has identified the following procedures, specific to the forensic portion of the exam as *eligible for reimbursement* by AST:

- Head to toe physical assessment (related only to the sexual assault) with colposcope examination of anogenital area;
- Completion of all necessary steps in the sexual assault evidence collection kit;
- Photographs of genital and non-genital injuries;
- Wet mounts for yeast infections, BV (bacterial vaginosis) and Trich (trichomoniasis);
- Cultures for gonorrhea and chlamydia when there are cervical abnormalities;
- Follow-up physical assessment with photography, colposcope examination and wet mounts, if indicated by the initial exam;
- Transportation to and from the initial and follow-up exam;
- AST will cover the cost of toxicology screening if warranted based on the history provided by the victim. The officer must have authorized the toxicology screening;
- AST will cover the cost of DNA testing of mother, baby or aborted tissue if necessary and Department of Law (DOL) has been consulted;

Under no circumstances will AST pay/reimburse the following:

- Medications of any type.
- · Pregnancy testing.
- · Abortions or "morning after pill."
- Treatment of injuries.
- Payments for more than one medical provider, unless the sexual assault exam is done via long-distance (teleforensics).
- HIV, hepatitis A, B, C or syphilis testing.

To access the grant funds you must submit specific information to AST. AST will need the following information:

- 1. An invoice from your department to AST.
- 2. A copy of the original invoice from the hospital or SART program. The invoice must be dated September 15, 2009 or after.
- 3. A memo stating that your agency screen and authorized the forensic portion of the exam including toxicology and a follow-up forensic exam;
- 4. The memo should also state that you have screened the invoice and the charges that you paid were for the forensic portion of the exam only.
- 5. The memo should indicate that the exam is for an adult victim of an SA.
- 6. We are requiring that you invoice AST within 45 days of the original bill.
- 7. All invoices should be sent to AST 5700 East Tudor Rd. Anchorage, AK 99507 attention: Dale Galosich.
