

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9 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY HEREBY RESOLVES:



11 **Section 1.** That SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
12 SEVENTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$639,874) is appropriated as a grant from the Department of  
13 Homeland Security for the development and implementation of the Port Wide Risk  
14 Management/Mitigation Plan, Business Continuity/Resumption of Trade Plan, Port Business  
15 Plan and identified additions to the security infrastructure at the Port.

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17 **Section 2.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by  
18 the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.

7 A SUSTAINABLE, RISK-BASED EFFORT FOR THE PROTECTION OF

9 ANCHORAGE (PORT) SECURITY PROGRAM

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11 The Municipality of Anchorage through the Port has been awarded a three-year grant from June 2009  
12 to May 2012 from the Department of Homeland Security FEMA, Grant Programs Directorate, for  
13 costs associated with creating a sustainable, risk-based plan for the protection of critical Port  
14 infrastructure from terrorism, especially explosive and non-conventional threats, that would cause  
15 major disruption to commerce and significant loss of life.

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17 Project I consists of the development and implementation of the Port Wide Risk  
18 Management/Mitigation Plan, Business Continuity/Resumption of Trade Plan, Port Business Plan  
19 and identified additions to the existing security infrastructure at the Port.
