12 promote the presence of Black women in government, in recent years - NOBEL/Women  
13 has expanded its vision to serve as a global voice addressing a myriad of issues affecting

16 WHEREAS, NOBEL/Women works to ensure the enforcement of responsible  
17 programs and policies that meet the legal, social, political, economic, education and health  
18 needs of children, women and families; and

20 WHEREAS, to that end, NOBEL/Women strives to keep governmental agencies  
21 accountable for implementing equitable laws and regulations that prohibit discrimination  
22 against women, promote equity and promote participation in the public and private sector;

25 WHEREAS, from June 24-27, 2010 NOBEL/Women will hold its 2010 Annual  
26 Legislative Conference, "Leading Women of the 21<sup>st</sup> Century: Transforming Health &  
27 Energy for the Future" at the Anchorage Downtown Marriott Hotel; and

29 WHEREAS, On Friday, June 25<sup>th</sup>, at NOBEL/Women's 2010 Annual Legislative  
30 Conference opening breakfast, NOBEL/Women President - Senator Sharon Broome,  
31 NOBEL/Women Treasurer - Senator Bettye Davis, Senate President Gary Stevens, and  
32 Lieutenant Governor Craig Campbell will present their greetings;
