A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND DECLARING THE WEEK OF JUNE 28 - JULY 2, 2010 AS "AMERICAN FEDERATION OF GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES (AFGE) WEEK" IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE.
