<u>Section 1.</u> The sum of FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$50,000) is hereby appropriated through the Mat-Su Borough, to the Department of Neighborhoods, Federal Grant Fund (241) as matching funds for the ARRA of 2009 EECBG Program Regional Transit Authority Study.

<u>Section 2.</u> The sum of TWO THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$2,134) is hereby appropriated as a contribution from the Public Transportation Department, to the Department of Neighborhoods, Federal Grant Fund (241) to cover costs of administrative services related to the ARRA of 2009 EECBG Program Regional Transit Authority Study.

<u>Section 3.</u> This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Assembly.

FEDERAL GRANT FUND (241) AS MATCHING FUNDS TO THE ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND CONSERVATION BLOCK GRANT THE **AMERICAN RECOVERY** AND (EECBG) UNDER REINVESTMENT ACT (ARRA) OF 2009, FOR A REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY STUDY BETWEEN ANCHORAGE AND

MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH.

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The attached Assembly Resolution appropriates \$50,000 as matching funds for the Municipality's ARRA EECBG Program from the Mat-Su Borough and \$2,134 through the Public Transportation Department. The matching funds will be used to fund a Regional Transit Authority Study. The total allocation for the study is \$100,000, with the Municipality and Mat-Su Borough splitting the cost for the study equally. The Municipality's ARRA EECBG funding for this project was appropriated on November 17, 2009 under Assembly Resolution No. 2009-261.

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The Regional Transit Authority Study will look at opportunities and challenges regarding governance, operations, cost allocation, and funding resources for the development of a Regional Transit Authority. It will provide final recommendations to the Assembly and Administration regarding the feasibility of developing a Regional Transit Authority.

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The Department of Public Transportation is the lead entity for the Regional Transit Authority Study and will be primary liaison for the contract management. The Department of Neighborhoods is managing and coordinating several projects with various Municipal Departments under the ARRA EECBG Program and is the administrative lead for budget oversight, providing technical assistance on federal requirements and compliance, and submits the monthly grant reporting.

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Expenditures are approved from May 1, 2010 through September 14, 2012. The following budget detail is submitted:
