2 THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE MUNICIPALITY AT THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL  
3 ELECTION ON APRIL 5, 2011, AN ADVISORY BALLOT PROPOSITION ON WHETHER  
4 THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE SHOULD REQUIRE MANDATORY PHOTO  
5 IDENTIFICATION FOR SALE OF ALCOHOL BY PACKAGE LIQUOR STORES.

7 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

9 **Section 1.** That an Advisory Ballot Proposition in substantially the same form as  
10 appears in Section 2 below shall be placed on the ballot and submitted to the qualified  
11 voters of the Municipality at the regular municipal election of April 5, 2011.

25 **Section 3.** The proposition contained in Section 2 of this ordinance, presented to the  
26 qualified voters residing in the Municipality voting on the question in the election of April 5,  
27 2011, is an advisory vote only. It shall advise the Anchorage Assembly of the voters'  
28 preference on mandatory photo identification when alcoholic beverages are purchased at a  
29 package liquor store, but no enabling legislation is enacted.

31 **Section 4.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and  
32 approval by the Assembly.
