1 AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING  
2 ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 26.10.030, UTILITY RULES AND  
3 PROCEDURES, TO PRESCRIBE MUNICIPAL UTILITY RULES AND  
4 PROCEDURES APPLICABLE TO THE OPERATION AND MANAGEMENT OF  
5 THE MUNICIPAL LIGHT AND POWER UTILITY.

7 WHEREAS Charter Section 16.01, Municipal utilities, provides that the  
8 Assembly shall prescribe rules and procedures for the operation and management  
9 of municipal utilities; and

10  
11 WHEREAS, the Assembly finds it in the public interest to support  
12 diversification of energy supply; now therefore,

13  
14 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

15  
16 **Section 1.** Anchorage Municipal Code section 26.10.030 is hereby implemented  
17 to read as follows:


18  
19 **26.10.030 Utility rules and procedures.**

20  
21 A. Diversification of energy supply: Upon direction of the Assembly by  
22 resolution, the municipal utility shall use its best efforts in the  
23 negotiation of a purchase power agreement that supports  
24 diversification of energy supply as provided in the Assembly's direction.  
25 If the Assembly, in its sole discretion, determines that the  
26 municipal utility has been unsuccessful in reaching a timely  
27 agreement, the results of the negotiation shall be presented to the  
28 Assembly. If the Assembly, in its sole discretion, finds that the public  
29 interest would be served, the Chair shall appoint a negotiation  
30 committee chaired by a member of the Assembly, to further explore  
31 and facilitate terms and conditions of the a proposed agreement  
32 between the utility and an energy provider. , for approval by the  
33 Assembly. The Assembly shall identify and weigh factors in the public  
34 interest when taking action on a purchase power agreement that will  
35 diversify energy supply.

4 **Section 2.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and  
5 approval by the Assembly.
