A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY URGING ACTION IN SUPPORT OF THE SUSITNA HYDROELECTRIC PROJECT. WHEREAS, the State of Alaska Energy Policy (AS 44.99.115) established in 2010 has a goal of producing 50% of our electricity from renewable sources by 2025; and WHEREAS, electric consumers in the Alaska Railbelt now rely principally on nonrenewable sources of electricity; and WHEREAS, the future viability of those nonrenewable sources as the principal electric source is contrary to the new policy and is further undermined by regulatory issues and uncertainty of supply, all of which results in increasing rates; and WHEREAS, the proposed Susitna Hydroelectric Project at the Watana site is the best alternative that will ensure long term affordability and predictable low rates to ratepayers, and is the only alternative that will significantly reduce reliance on nonrenewable sources of electricity. NOW. THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves: Section 1: That the Assembly and Mayor urges the Alaska Legislature, Governor, and Congressional Delegation to expeditiously proceed with all necessary steps for the construction and operation of the Susitna Hydroelectric Project at Watana, including: Authorizing the Governor to expedite federal licensing: a. Appropriating \$65.7 million to prepare and submit a federal license; b. Authorizing an independent, focused Susitna Hydroelectric Authority to C. proceed in a timely, efficient, and cost effective manner with the development; and Creating a Susitna Hydroelectric Construction Fund and appropriating d. an initial investment. Section 2: That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.
