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10 **Section 1.** That the sum of Sixty-five Thousand Four Hundred Forty-four Dollars
11 (\$65,444) is hereby appropriated as a contribution from the Cook Inlet Tribal
12 Council, Inc. to the Federal Grants Fund (241) for Substance Abuse Prevention
13 and Intervention Services in the Department of Health and Human Services.

13 The Department of Health and Human Services received a grant from the Cook
14 Inlet Tribal Council, Inc. (CITC), for participation in the Substance Abuse and
15 Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) Strategic Prevention
16 Framework (SPF). The grant period is from October 1, 2011 through September
17 30, 2012.
18

19 The SPF is a community-based risk and protective factors approach to prevention
20 that can be operationalized at Federal, State/Tribal and Municipal/community
21 levels. SPF goals include: prevent the onset and reduce the progression of
22 substance abuse, including childhood and underage drinking; reduce substance
23 abuse-related problems in communities; and build prevention capacity and
24 infrastructure at the State/Tribal and community levels. Although the direct
25 recipients of SPF State Incentive Grant (SPF SIG) funds are States and federally
26 recognized Tribes and Tribal organizations, SAMHSA envisions the SPF SIGs
27 being implemented through partnerships between the States/Tribes and
28 communities such as the Municipality of Anchorage.

30 The three main program interventions proposed under the CITC grant are:
31 Communities Mobilizing for Change on Alcohol (CMCA), a community-organizing
32 program that seeks both to effectively limit the access to alcohol of people under
33 legal drinking age and to communicate a clear message to the community that
34 underage drinking is inappropriate and unacceptable; Brief Motivational
35 Intervention in primary care, a screening and assessment tool designed to identify
36 early warning signs of alcohol abuse in youth and provide intervention services;
37 and Second Order Strength-Based System Change, targeted at enhancing the
38 quality of adults' interaction with students in the Anchorage School District, as
39 research clearly demonstrates the potency of a young person's connection to
40 school as a powerful inoculator against substance abuse and other high risk
41 behavior.
