23.10.105.1 - General provisions.

C. Performing Work: All work regulated by this code shall be performed by individuals appropriately licensed in the relevant trade in accordance with state law and this code.

Exceptions:

- 1. A property owner may perform work as follows:
 - <u>a.</u> A person working on an existing structure on that person's own property, whether occupied by the person or not, and a person working on that person's own existing residence, whether owned by the person or not;
 - <u>b.</u>

 An owner or tenant of commercial property who uses the owner's or tenant's own employees to do maintenance, repair, and alteration work on that property.
 - [A. THE OWNER OF A DETACHED SINGLE-FAMILY HOME MAY PERFORM ANY TYPE OF WORK REGULATED BY THIS CODE ON THE STRUCTURE AS LONG AS THEY RESIDE IN THE HOME.
 - B. THE OWNER OF A DETACHED DUPLEX (TWO DWELLING UNITS) MAY PERFORM ANY TYPE OF WORK REGULATED BY THIS CODE ON THE STRUCTURE AS LONG AS THEY RESIDE IN ONE OF THE UNITS.
 - C. THE OWNER OF A COMMERCIAL BUILDING
 AND THEIR EMPLOYEES MAY PERFORM
