APPEALS TO THE BOARD OF BUILDING REGULATION EXAMINERS AND APPEALS

Anchorage Municipal Code (AMC) Title 23, Part 23.10.103 allows for appeal of orders, decisions or determinations made by the Building Official relative to the application and interpretations of the technical code. Part 23.45 also allows for appeals of certain orders of the Fire Official. Appeals are made to the Building Board of Regulations Examiners and Appeals.

- 1. Some reasons for appealing to the Building Board may be:
 - a. difference of opinion in interpretation of code;
 - b. denial of a request for alternate methods and materials.
- 2. The procedure for filing an appeal is:
 - a. The appellant must pay a \$100.00 filing fee and submit their notarized appeal to the Building Board Secretary, who schedules a hearing date.
 - i. Materials presented to the board may not exceed a five page executive summary.
 - ii. Supporting documents, such as drawings and/or calculations may not exceed 15 pages.
 - iii. Materials must be turned in 7 days before the meeting to staff.
 - iv. Time allowed for initial case presentation is limited to 10 minutes; staff and the appellant shall each have 30 minutes to present; the appellant shall have 15 minutes for rebuttal.
 - b. A staff report presenting Building Safety's or Fire Prevention's opinions is prepared and will be available to the appellant at least seven (7) days prior to the hearing date.
 - The notice of appeal and hearing date is posted in the Municipality's electronic calendar system.
- 3. <u>Appellant or their representative must appear</u> before the Building Board on the specified date and time to plead their own case. Legal counsel may be utilized by the appellant, but is not required. Specific procedures governing appeals are described in the Anchorage Municipal Code of Regulations (AMCR) 3.40.4.05.120. 23.10.010.
- 4. In most cases, decisions are rendered at the time of the hearing.
- 5. If appeal is denied, the appellant may further appeal to the Alaska Superior Court within 30 days.
