## a. Aquifer Testing for Subdivisions

It was agreed to either include the procedures in 15.55.090 subdivision submittal or reference them. The previous language that was proposed was:

• Water Availability. A proposed subdivision that will be served by private wells must be supported by information which shows that adequate water will be available to serve the proposed wells and the existing neighboring wells. A proposed subdivision with more than 5 lots to be served with private wells must have an aquifer test performed by a hydrogeologist, see Aquifer Testing Guidelines.

Initially Mr. Munter suggested the language be removed from code but then reconsidered and would like it included now.
