1. CALL TO ORDER/ ROLL CALL

CHAIR Swenson called the meeting to order at 11:35 a.m. A quorum was established. Mr. Henslee was unavailable.

2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA / MINUTES

CHAIR Swenson asked the board to review the agenda. Mr. Garness motioned, and Mr. Barrington seconded. Approved unanimously.

Chair Swenson asked the board to review the minutes of February 15, 2023, and April 1, 2023. Mr. Garness motioned to approve the minutes of February 15, 1012, and April 12, 2023. Mr. Sauer seconded. Approved unanimously.

4. OTHER BUSINESS/INFORMATIONAL

a. Water Softener verbiage

Mr. Garness' inquired how staff was doing on getting records drawings turned in. Staff noted they haven't checked lately but believe the pile has grown because they haven't had time to contact anyone.

c. Public comment

Mr. Varney asked if staff had met with Mike Anderson regarding a holding tank. Staff replied they had met with him and has not heard back from him. He noted he had not heard back from him either.

Mr. Varney estimates between 35 and 40% of AdvanTex systems do not have remote monitoring capabilities. This is due to homeowners not willing to connect, landlines no longer connected to the house, or homeowners not knowing this is required.
