1. CALL TO ORDER/ ROLL CALL

CHAIR Swenson called the meeting to order at 11:35 a.m. A quorum was established. Mr. Henslee was unavailable.

2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA / MINUTES

CHAIR Swenson asked the board to review the agenda. Mr. Garness motioned to approve the agenda. Mr. Sauer second the motion. *The agenda was unanimously approved*.

The assembly has recognized there are two different scenarios, where part of the community is on public water and sewer, and the other part of the community on well and septic.

Staff noted they will email Mr. Henslee regarding his reappointment. It was asked what gets you kicked off the board.
