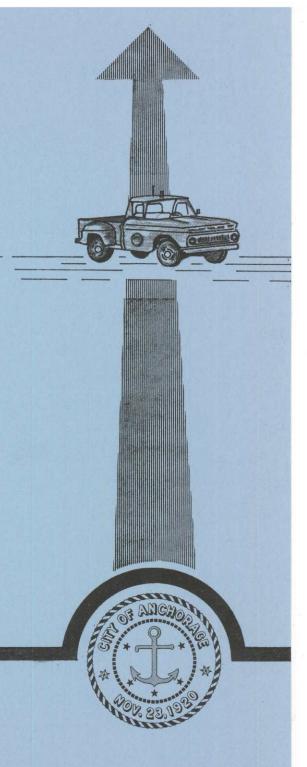

AUTOMOTIVE PROGRAM

The Equipment & Supply Section, a unit of the Department of Public Works, Maintenance Operations Division, is an intra-governmental service organization providing essential automotive equipment services to all City departments.

Services offered by the E&S section range from writing specifications for new or replacement equipment to arranging for the disposal of equipment at the end of their useful life. In between these two extremes, the E&S section services, repairs, and maintains vehicles and equipment comprising the City fleet.

Monies expended for operating expenses is recovered through rental and interfund charges to the various City departments, on a monthly basis.

For 1973, the Telephone Utility, Municipal Light & Power, and the Water Utility will pay for all work performed on their equipment on a job order basis. All equipment previously contributed by these utilities to the E&S section will have been transferred back to the utilities by the end of 1972.

- Goal: To maintain an up-to-date and adequate automotive repair and service facility that is capable of providing automotive services in an efficient and effective manner.
 - Objective 1973-1 Purchase shop tools and equipment for Telephone garage and Main garage, to improve and speed-up services(see Machinery & Equipment section of schedule D.)
 - Objective 1973-2 Increase manpower level to take care of increased workload resulting from increase in size of City fleet(see Salaries section of schedule D, and "Statistical Highlights".)
