PUBLIC COMMENT:

Kyle Kelley: Girdwood Service Area is working with the MOA and Whittier Police toward abatement of homeless camps in park and ride parking lot and in Girdwood Park. Girdwood abatement is based on public safety and human health concerns. GVSA and WPD have contacted the people living there and have engaged with the Anchorage CAP team and local resources for homeless people.

Abatement takes time. Municipal code requires 10 days' notice prior to abatement, in Anchorage, with much larger camps, 20 days' notice has been provided. Municipality is waiting for outcome of Martin v Boise Supreme Court case to establish parameters of abatement more broadly.
