A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND HONORING  
CHRYSTAL CARR JETER FOR HER 23 YEARS OF SERVICE WITH THE MUNICIPALITY OF  
ANCHORAGE

WHEREAS, on August 8, 1977, Chrystal Carr Jeter began her employment with the Municipality  
of Anchorage at the Anchorage Municipal Libraries; and

WHEREAS, during her tenure, she served as Branch Librarian at the Spenard and Muldoon  
Branch Libraries, the Assistant Municipal Librarian for Community Services, and as the Youth Services  
Coordinator since 1989; and

WHEREAS, throughout her Municipal career, the number of programs for children has increased,  
and her goal of providing excellence in children's literature has been maintained because of her effective  
public relations and strong voice for children within the community; and

WHEREAS, Chrystal's expertise was recognized through various avenues which included her seat  
on the prestigious American Library Association's Newbery Book Award Committee, and the numerous  
awards she received for Youth Services publications from the Alaska Federation of Press Women, and  
the National Federation of Press Women; and

WHEREAS, appreciation for Chrystal's abilities broadened when she was honored with several  
Aurora Awards from the Public Relations Society of Alaska for Excellence in Public Relations, received  
an award from the Alaska Black Caucus in recognition of excellence, served as a finalist in the BP/YWCA  
Women of Achievement Award and, most recently, received 1<sup>st</sup> place awards both locally and nationally  
for the 1999 Summer Reading Program; and

WHEREAS, her dedication to public service and tenacity of purpose has been strong and is  
appreciated by the Anchorage Municipal Libraries and the community as a whole; and

WHEREAS, on January 19, 200, Chrystal will leave the Municipality of Anchorage to bring her  
expertise and enthusiasm to the children and community of Cleveland, Ohio.
