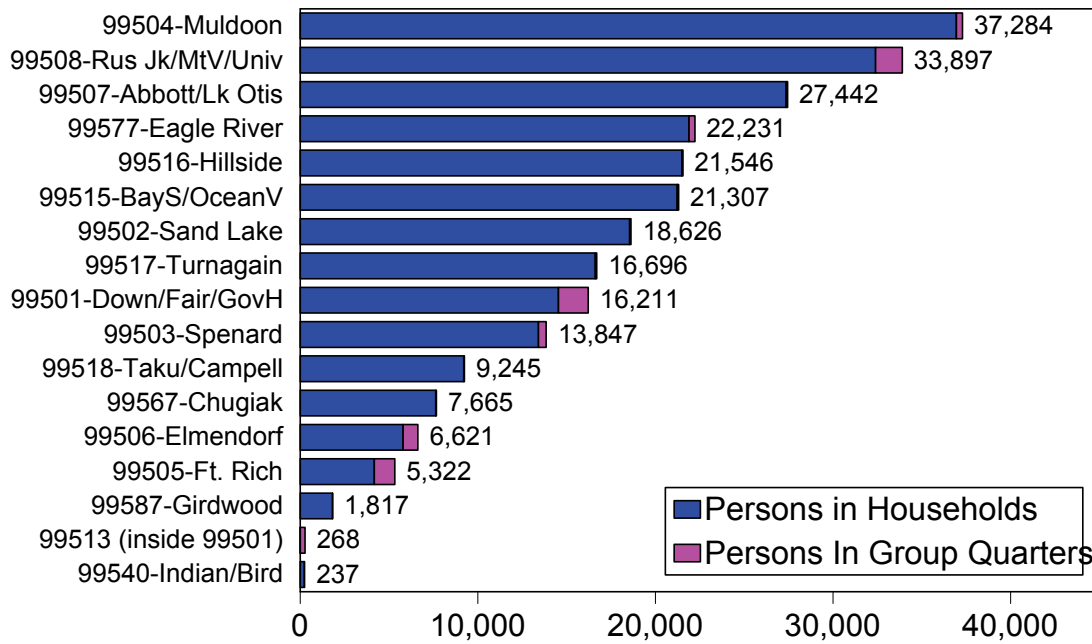

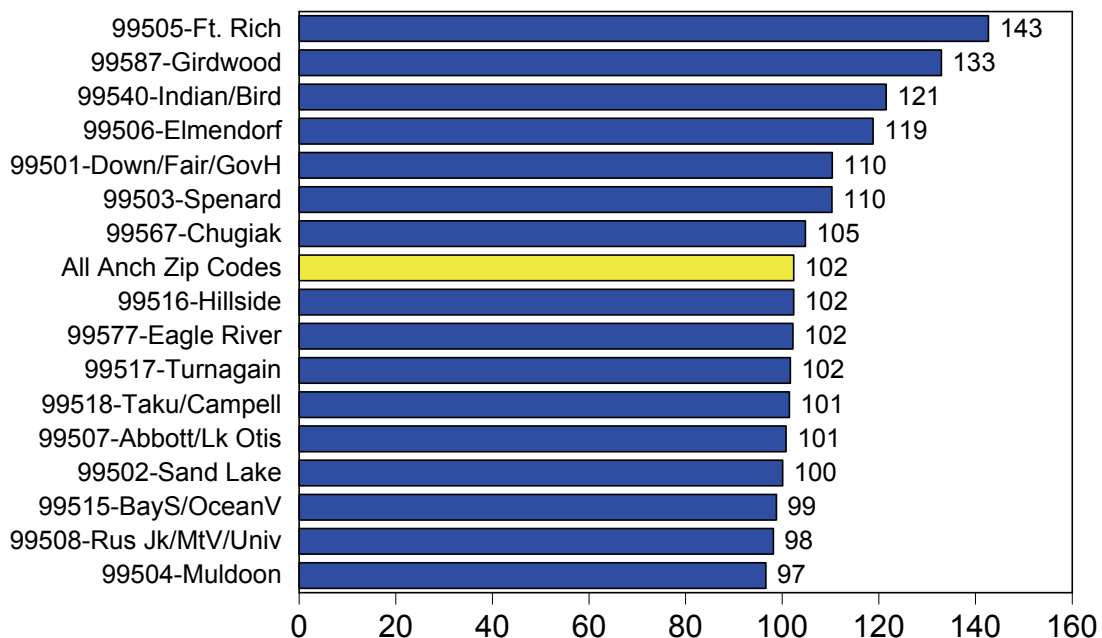
Living in Households & Group Quarters - 2000

Anchorage Population by Age and Zip Code - 2000

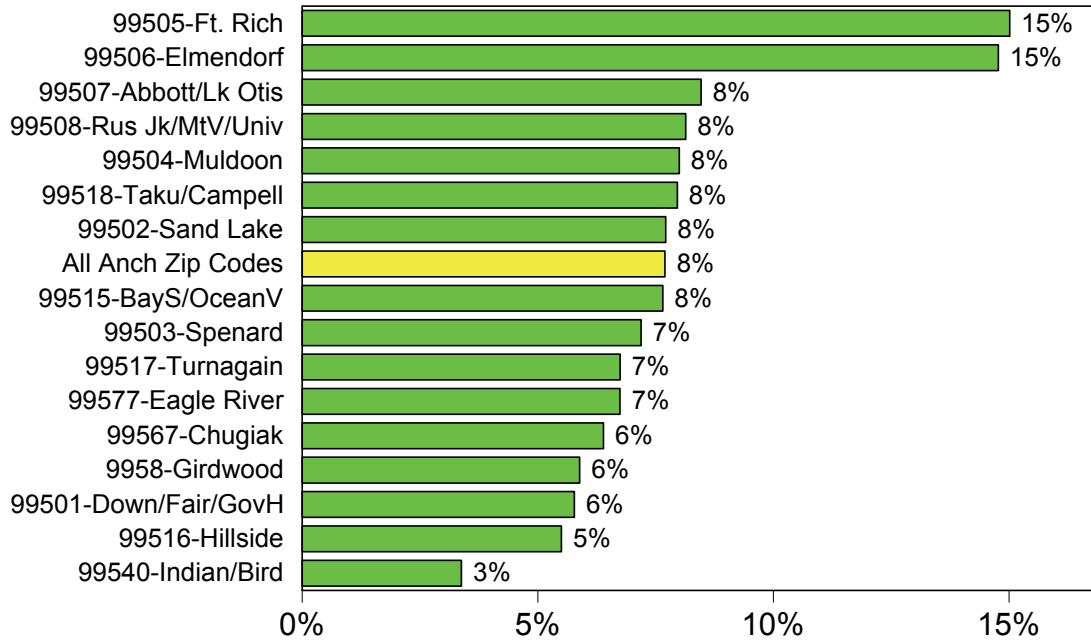

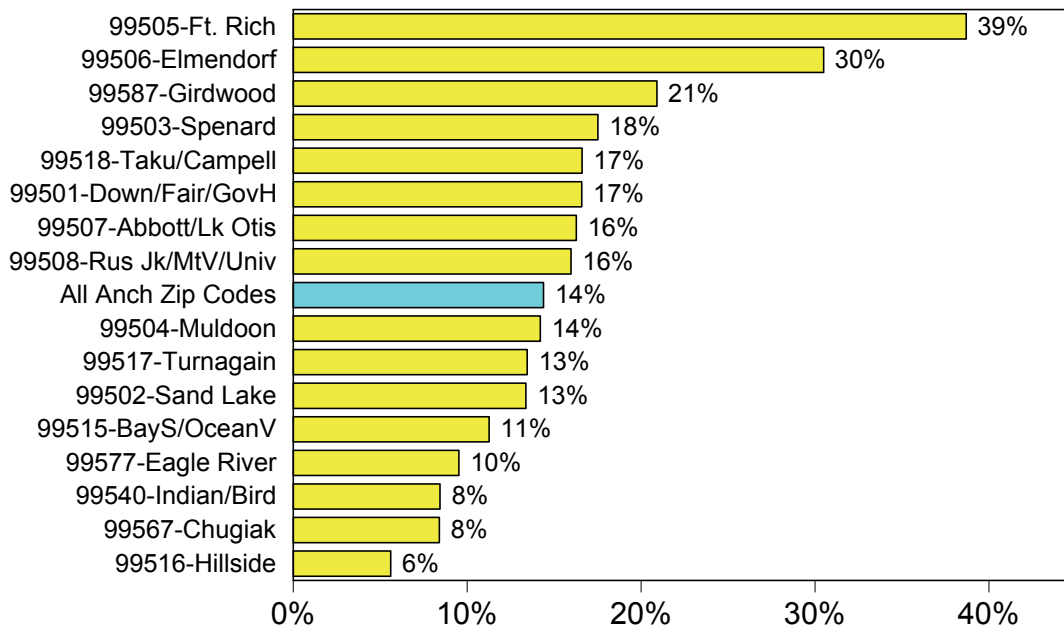
Anchorage Zip Codes - 2000

% Young Adults (20-29 years)

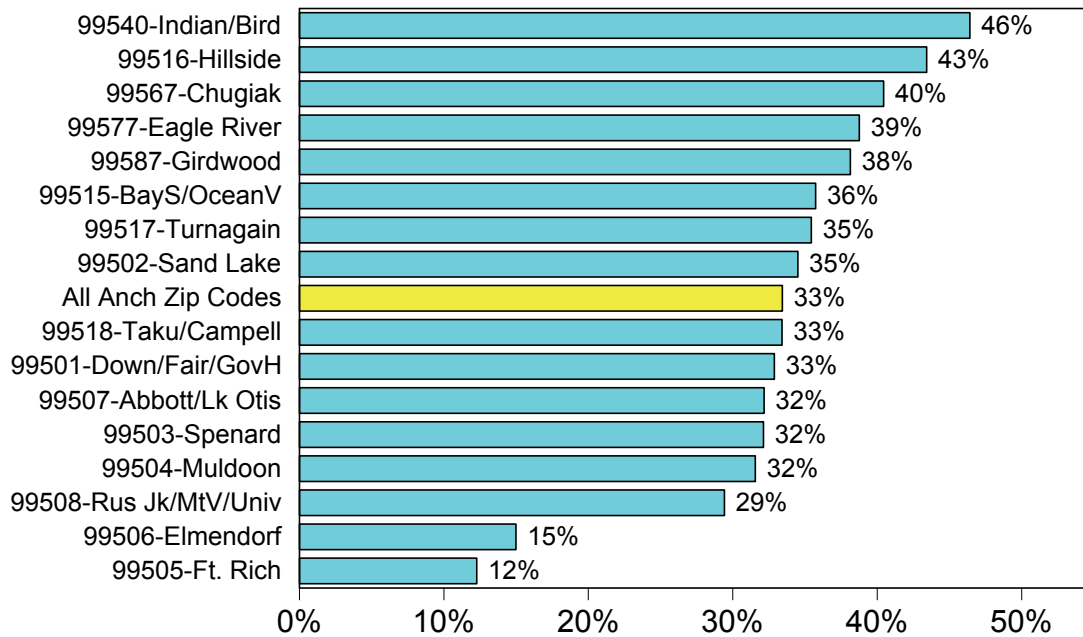

% Baby Boomers*(Age 35-54)

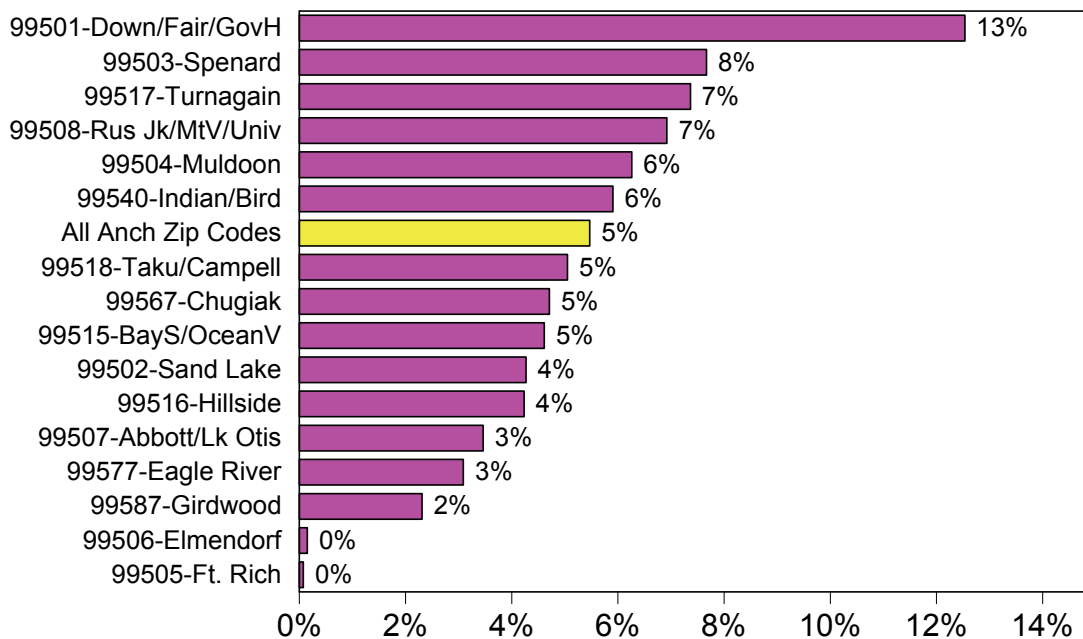

% Seniors (Age 65 & Up)

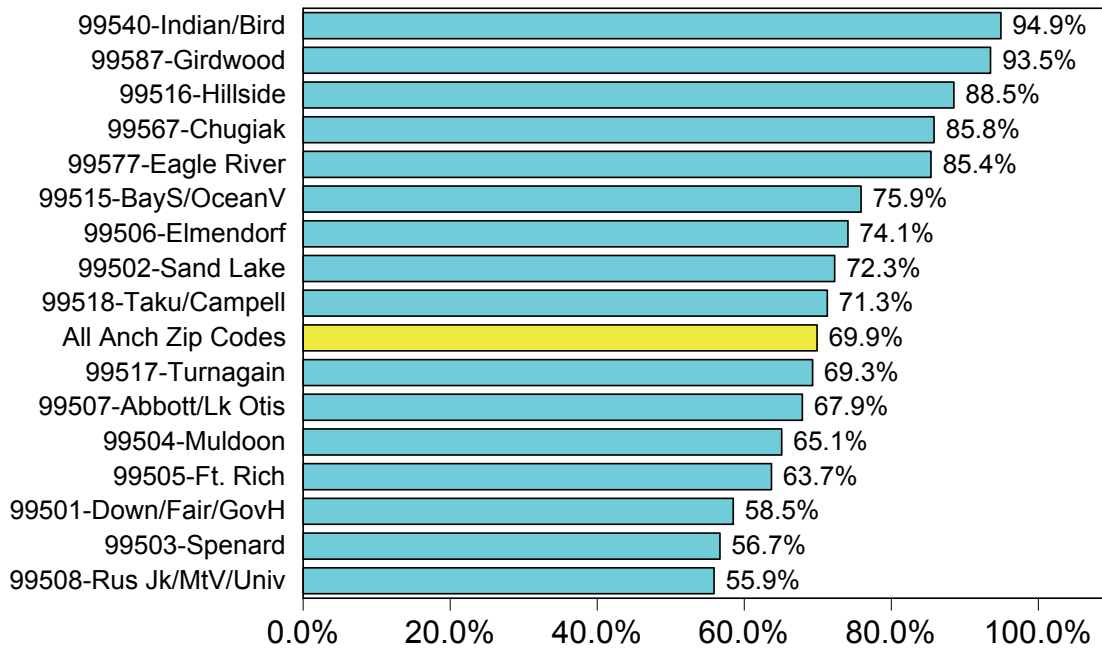

% White Non-Hispanics

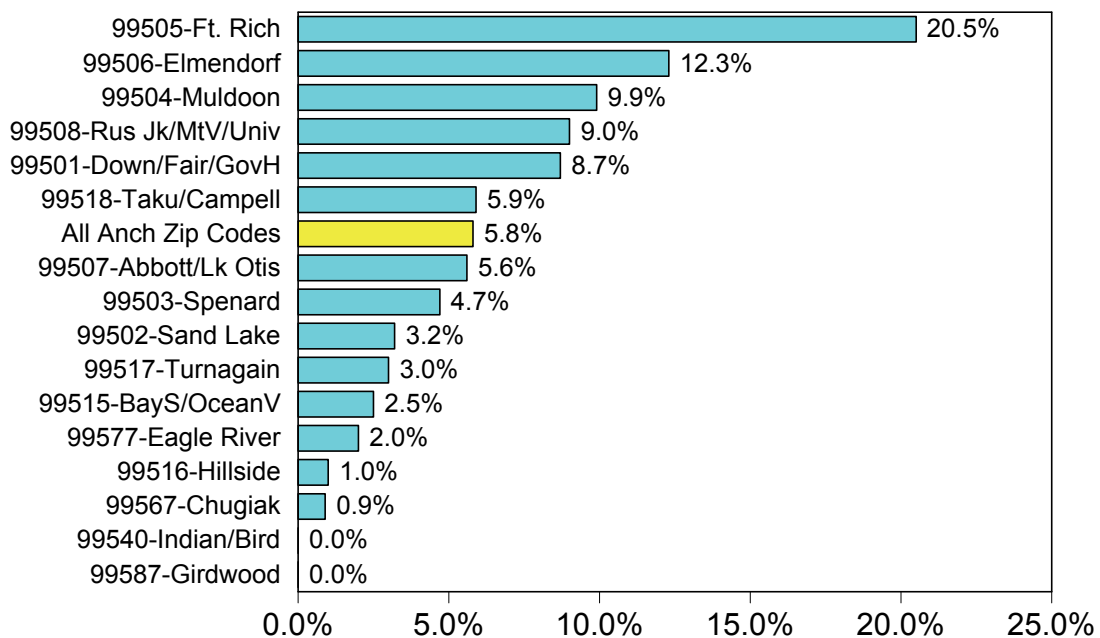

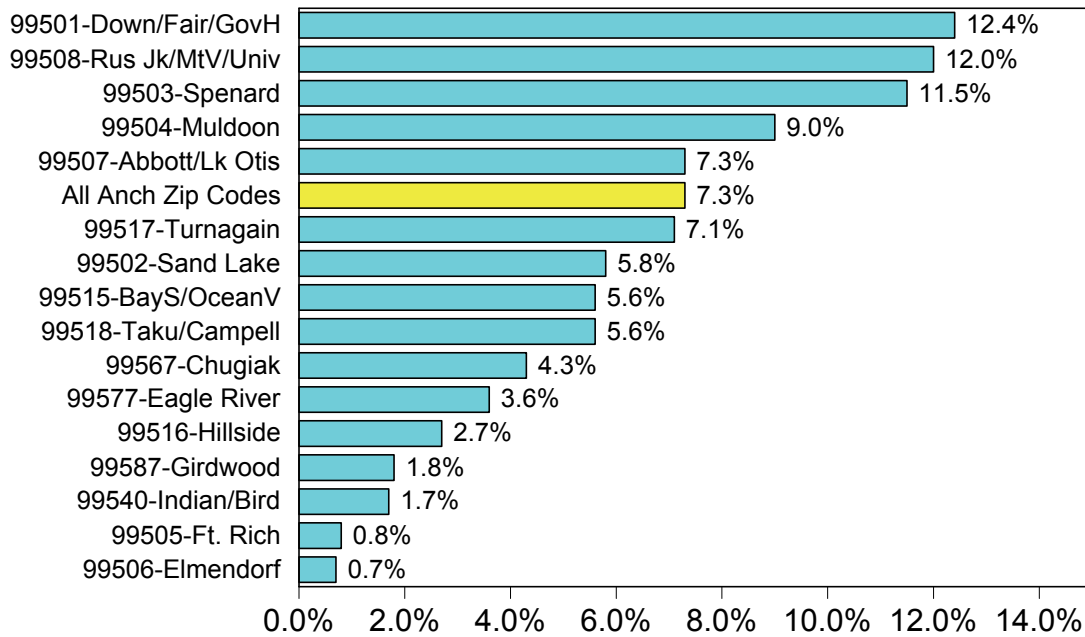

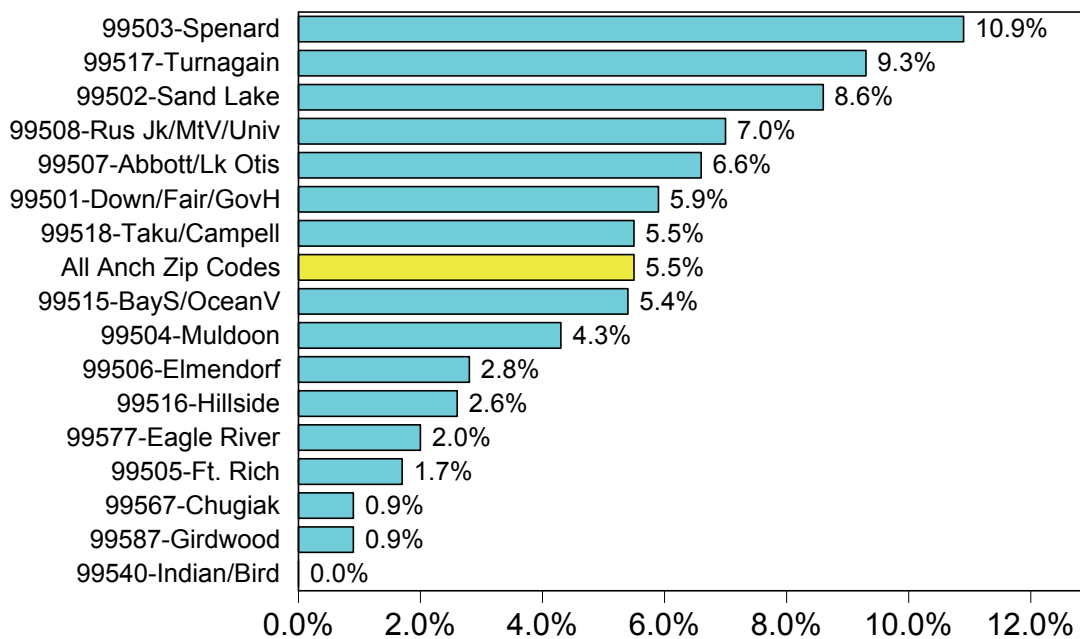
Anchorage Zip Codes - 2000

% Asians

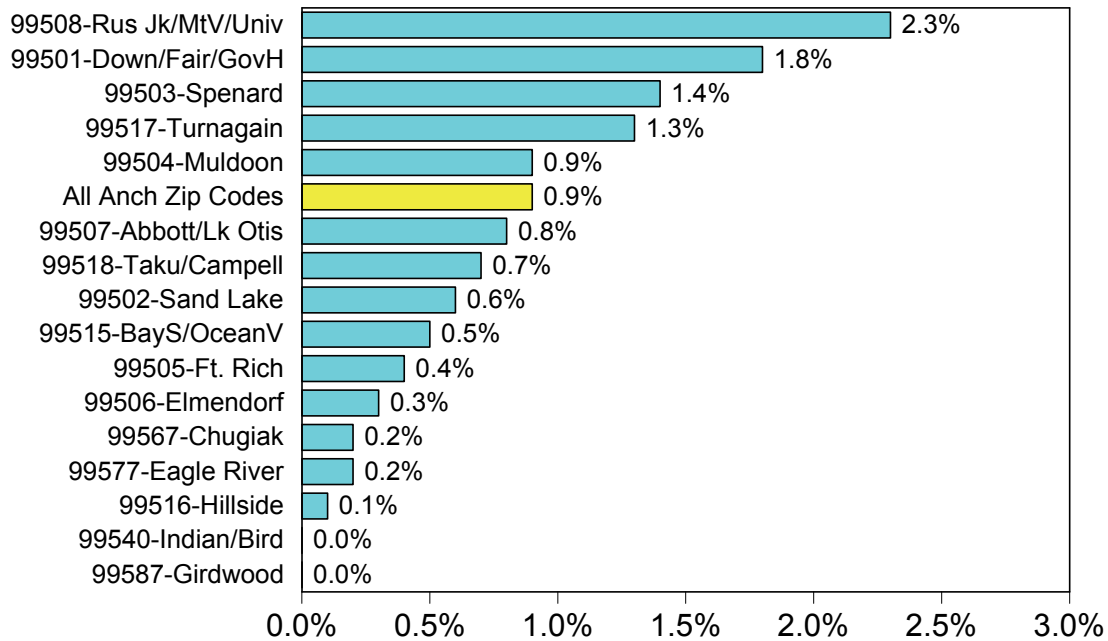
Anchorage Zip Codes - 2000

% Hawaiians & Pacific Islanders

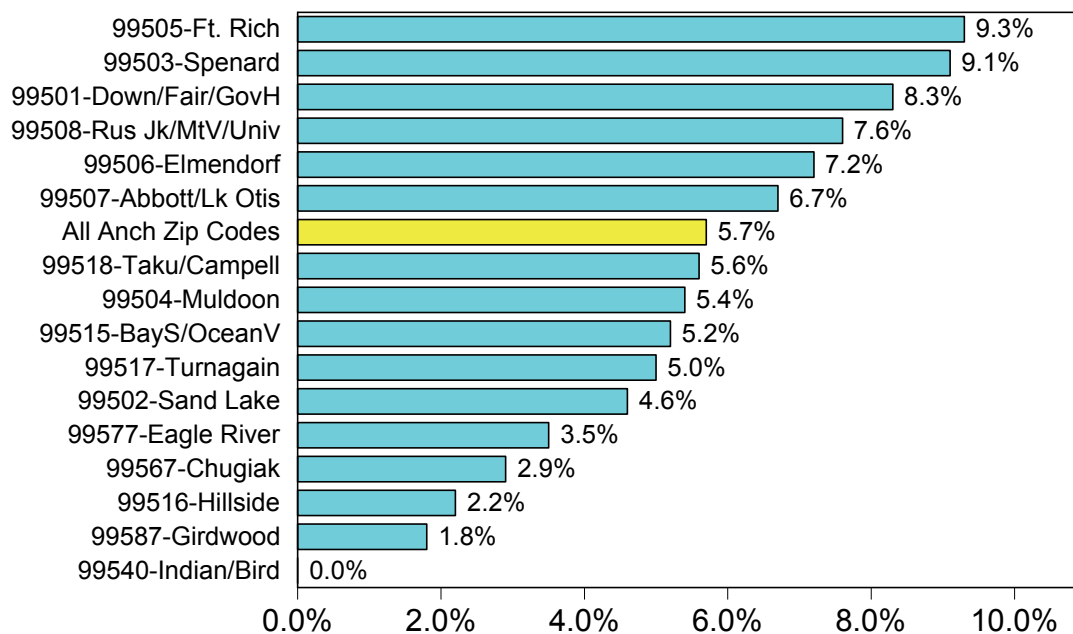

Anchorage Zip Codes - 2000



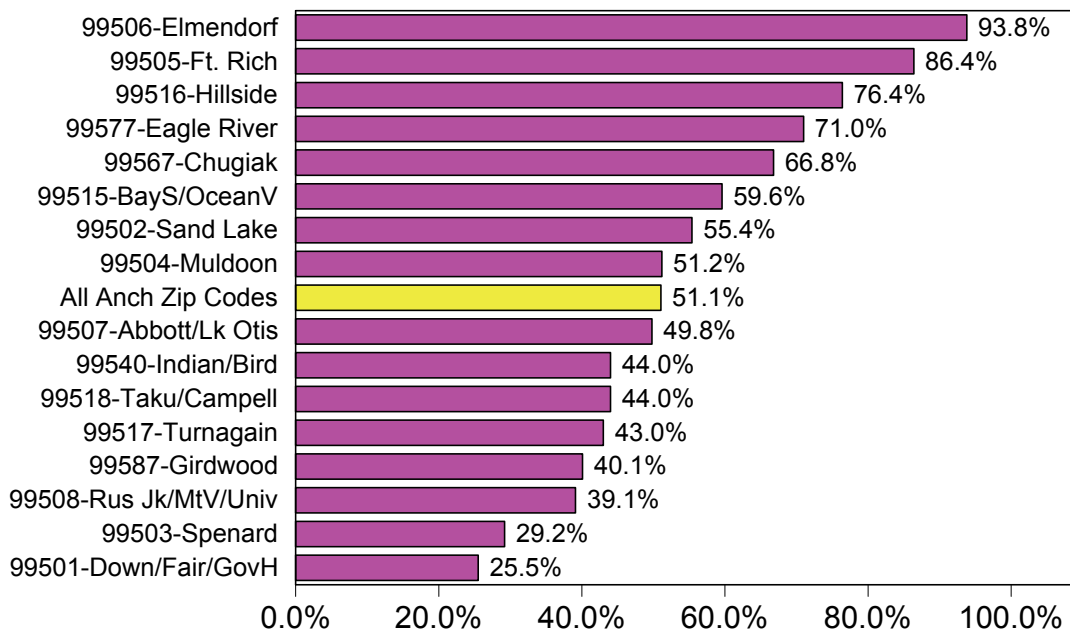

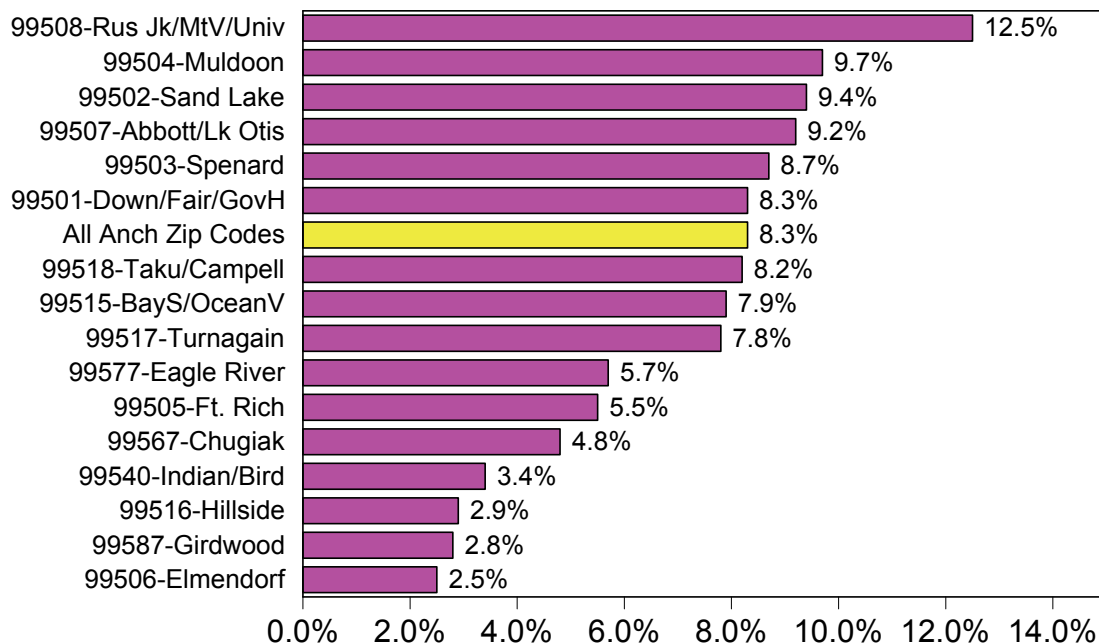

% Single-Parent Females w/Children*

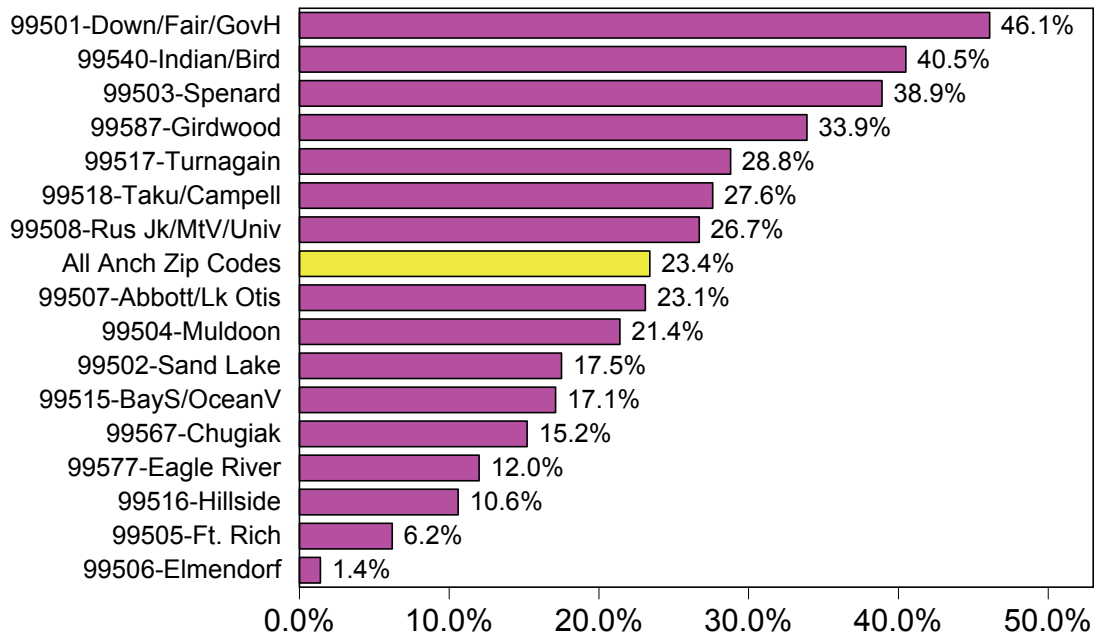

% One Person Households

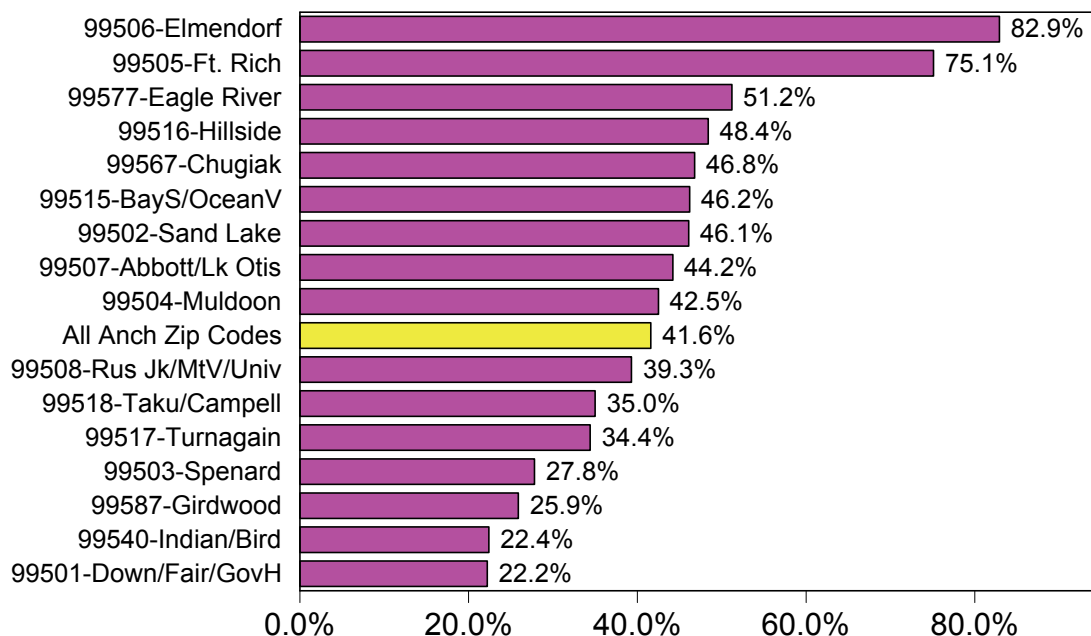

Anchorage Zip Codes - 2000



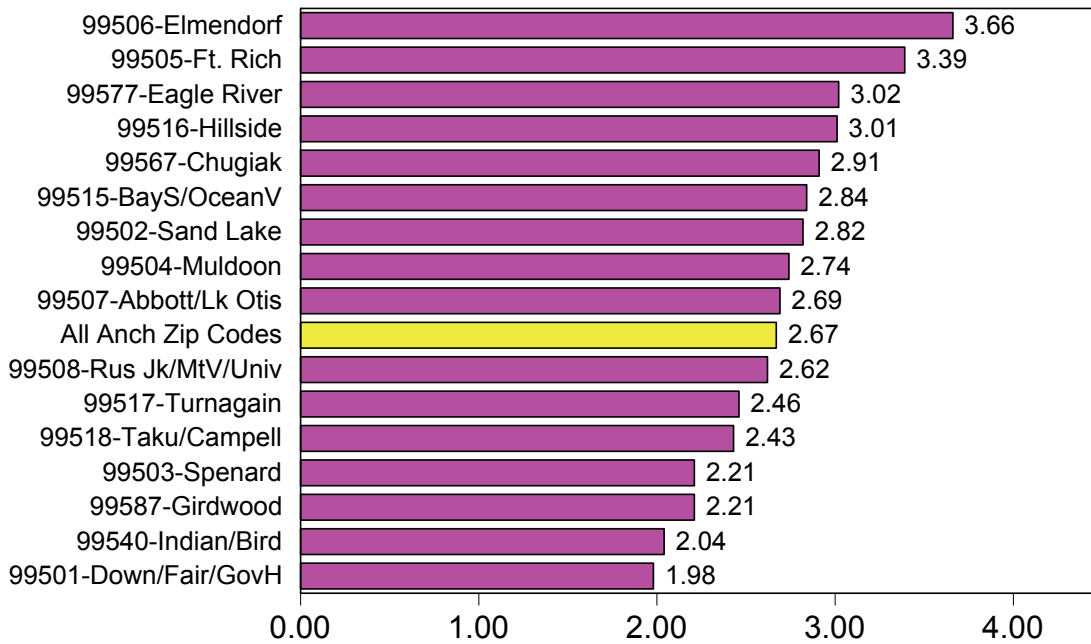

Average Persons Per Household

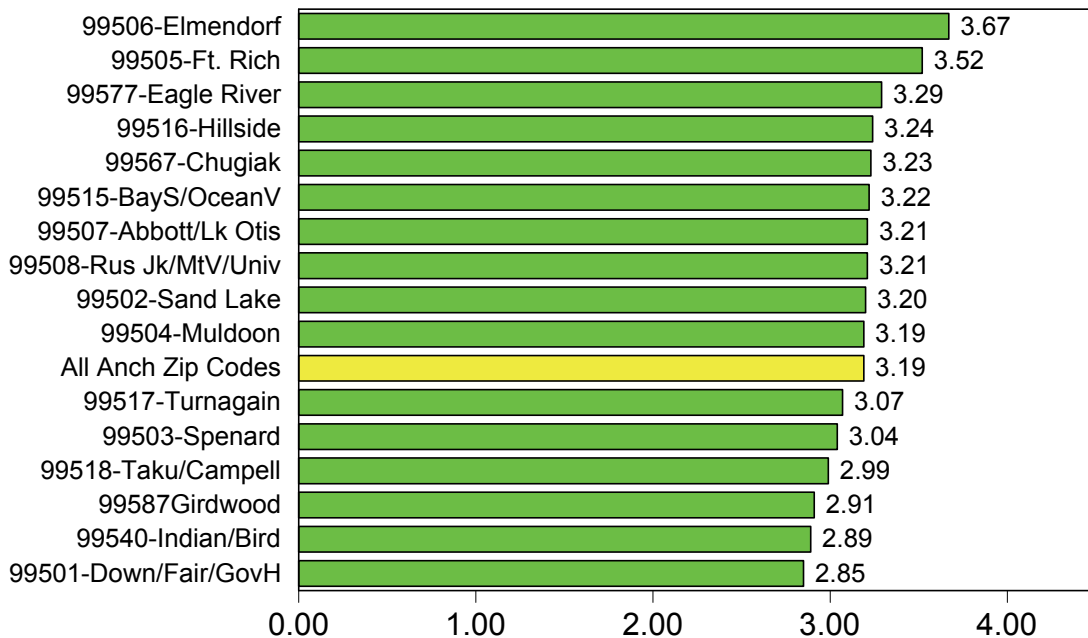

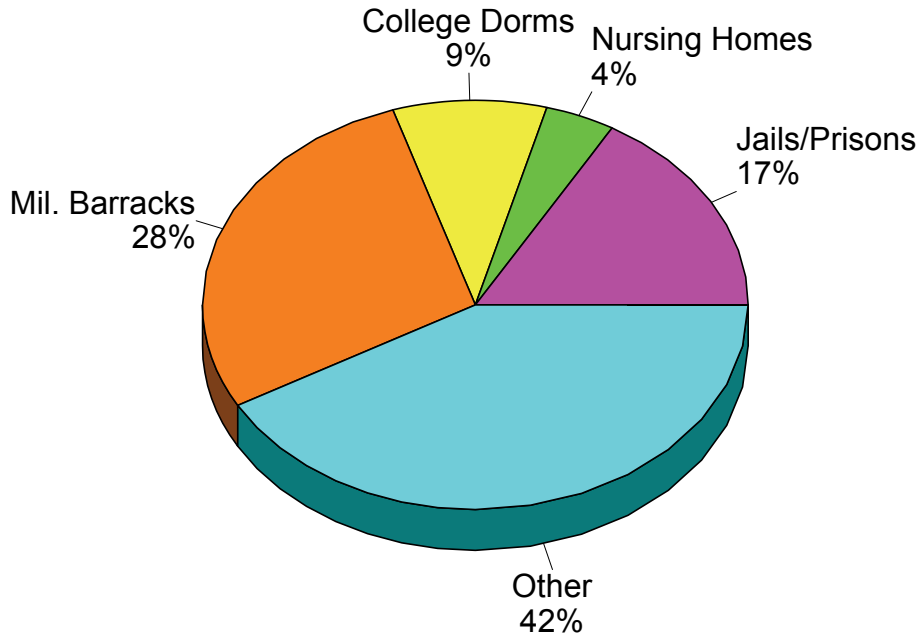

Persons in Group Quarters

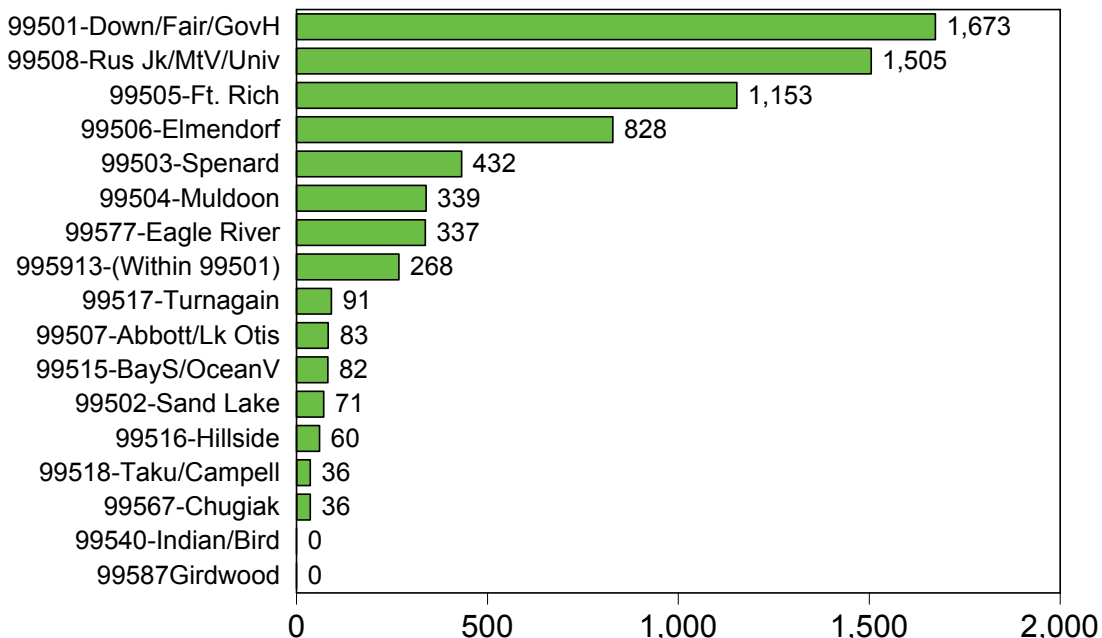
Anchorage - 2000

Anchorage Zip Codes - 2000



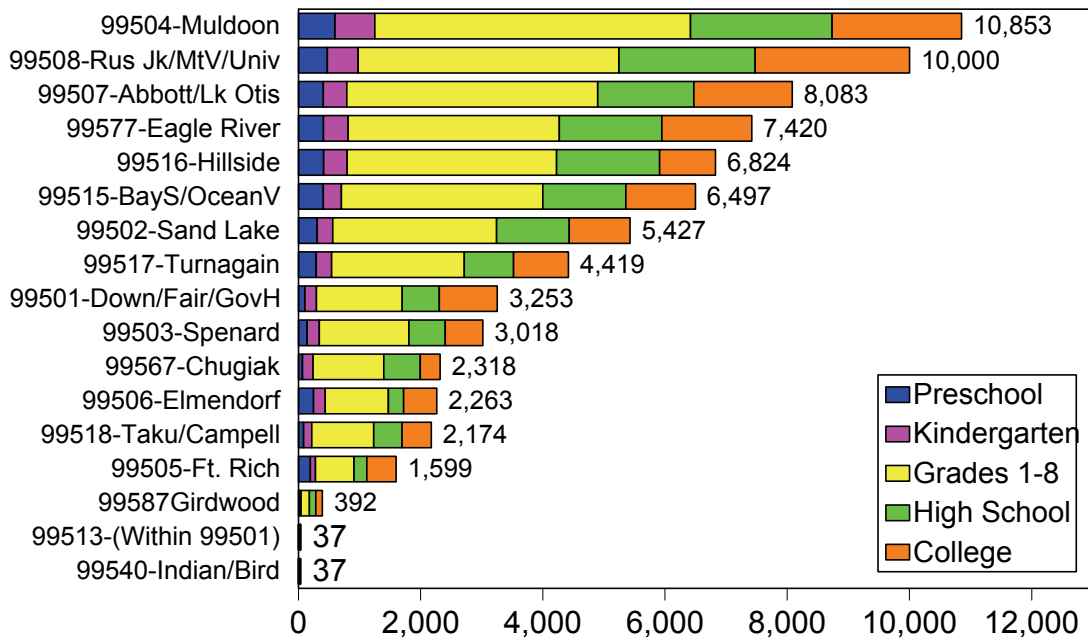

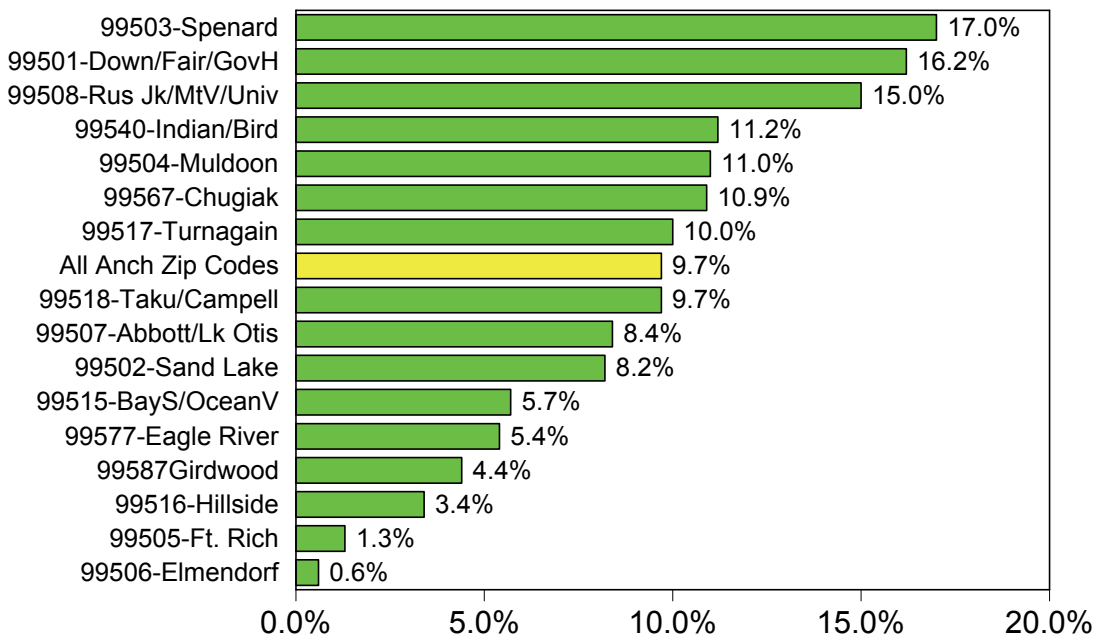

Anchorage Persons 25 Yrs. & Over by Zip Codes - 2000



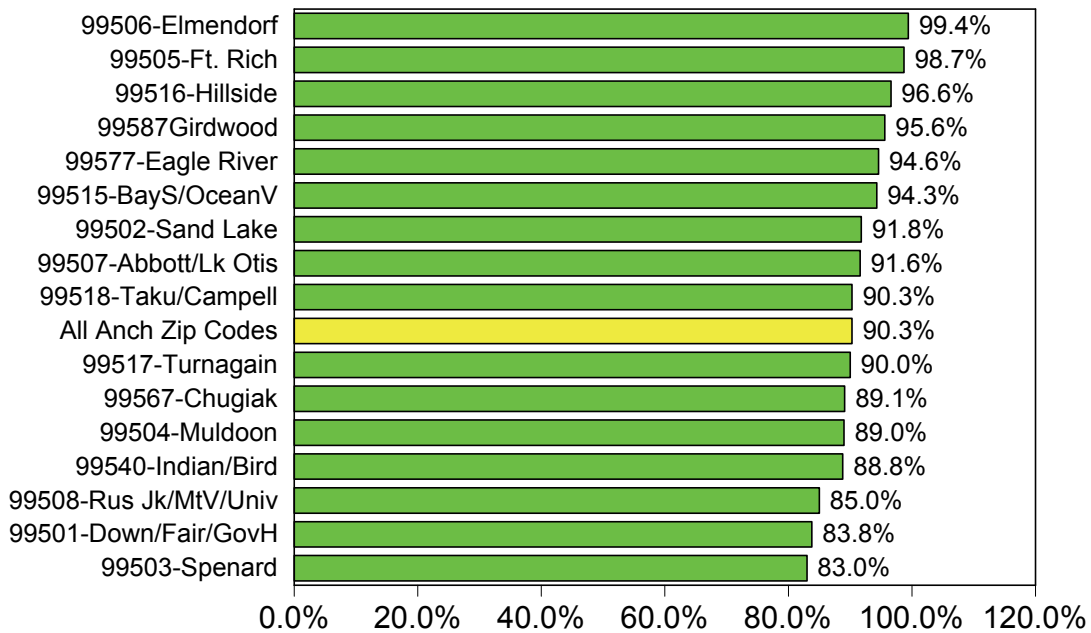

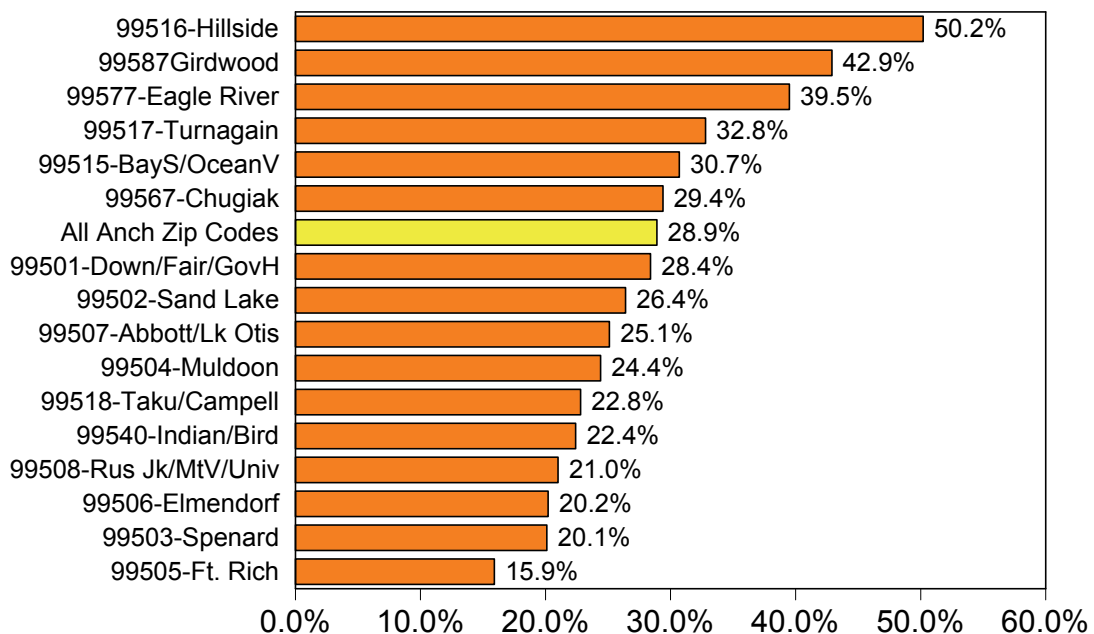

%College Graduates

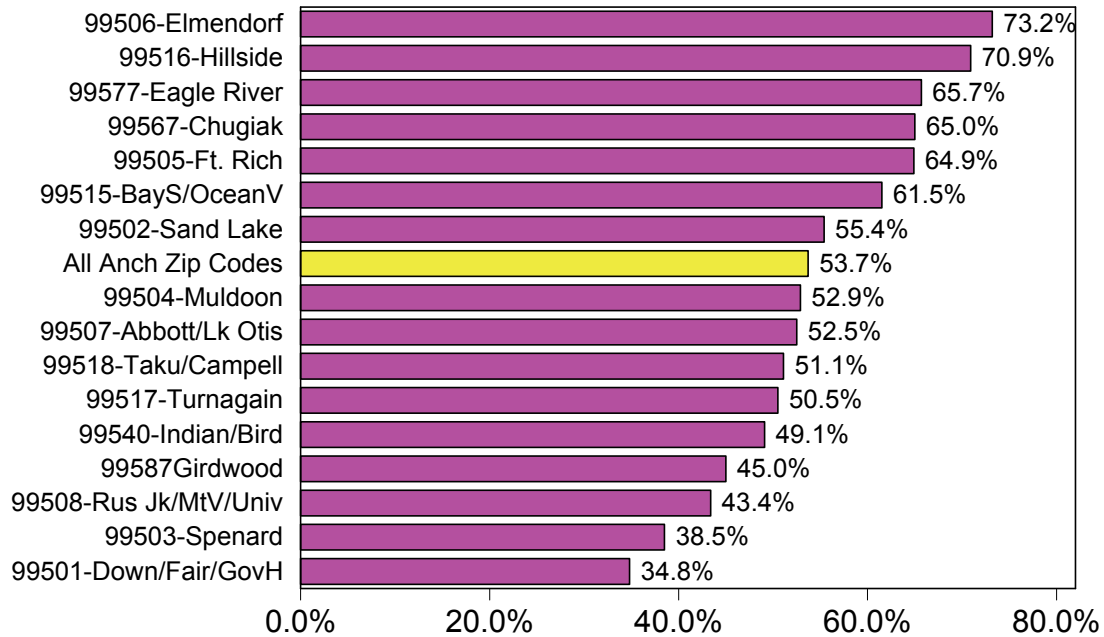

%Married* by Zip Code

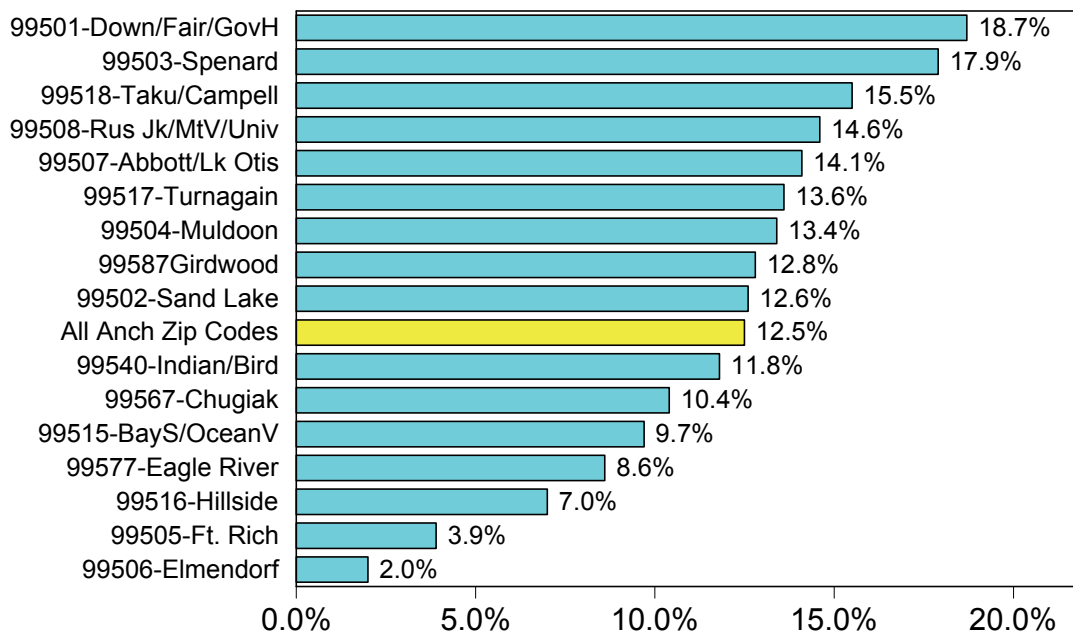
Anchorage Persons 15 & Older - 2000

%Divorced by Zip Code

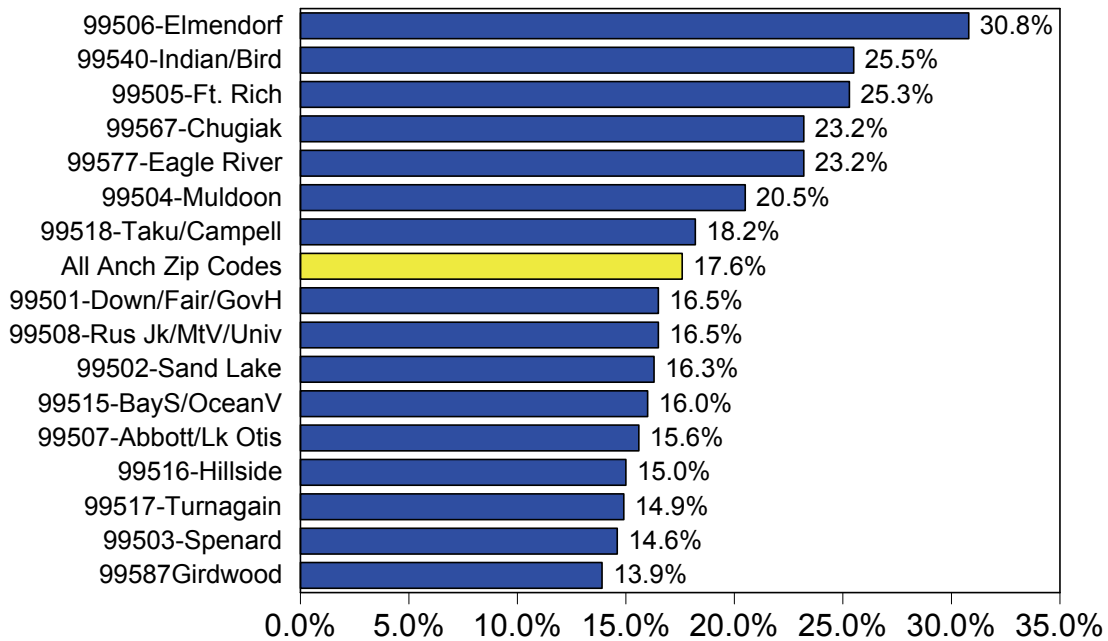

%Veterans by Zip Code

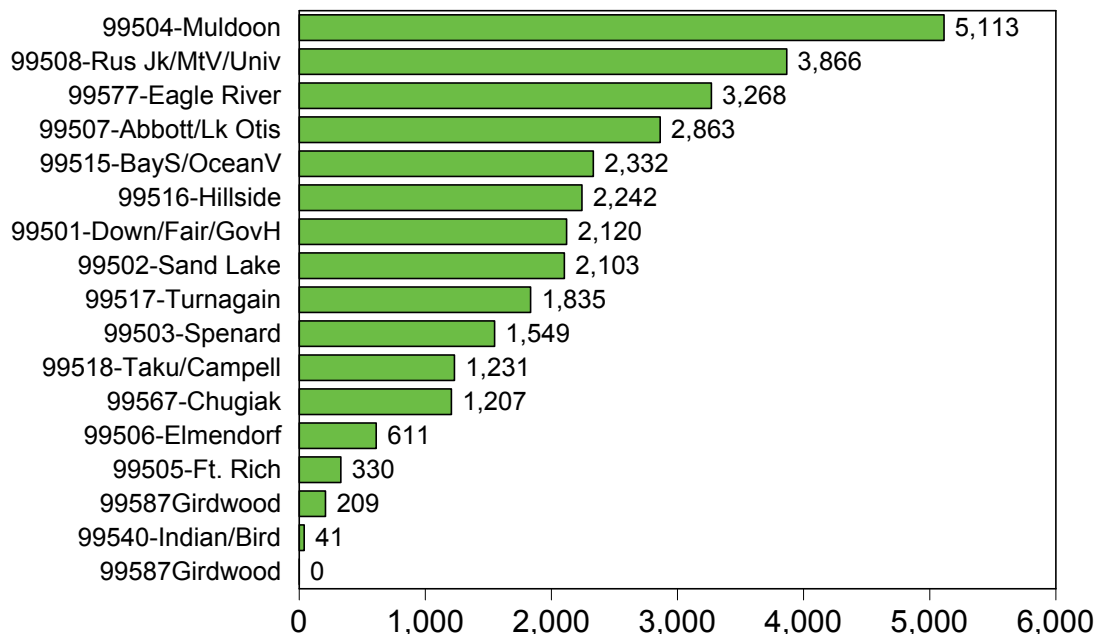
Civilian Population 18 & Over - 2000

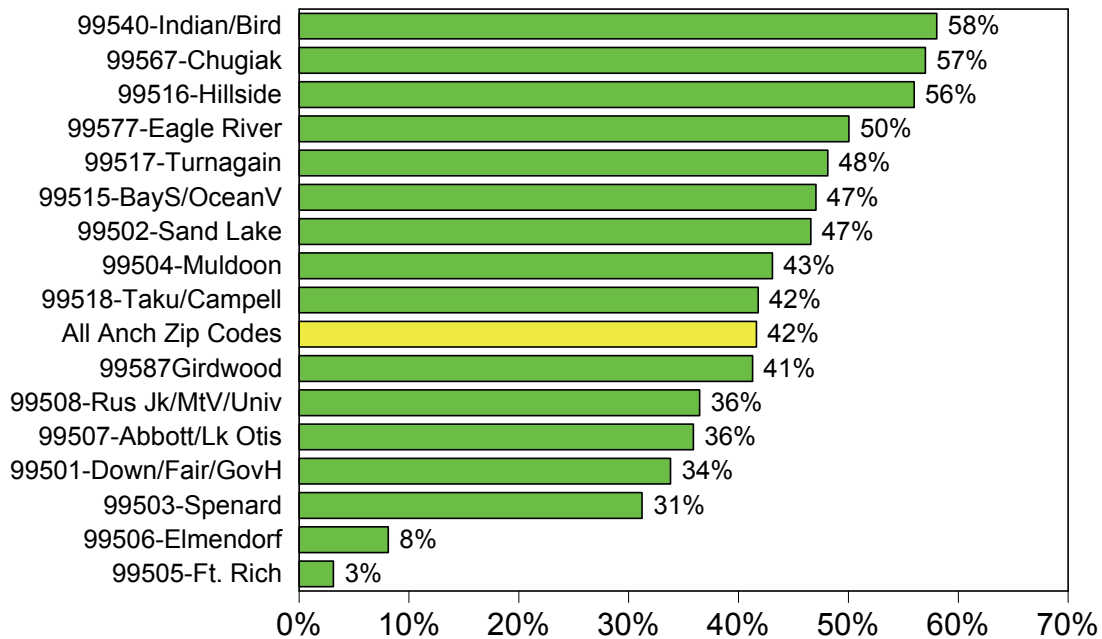

%Living in Same House 5 Yrs. Ago

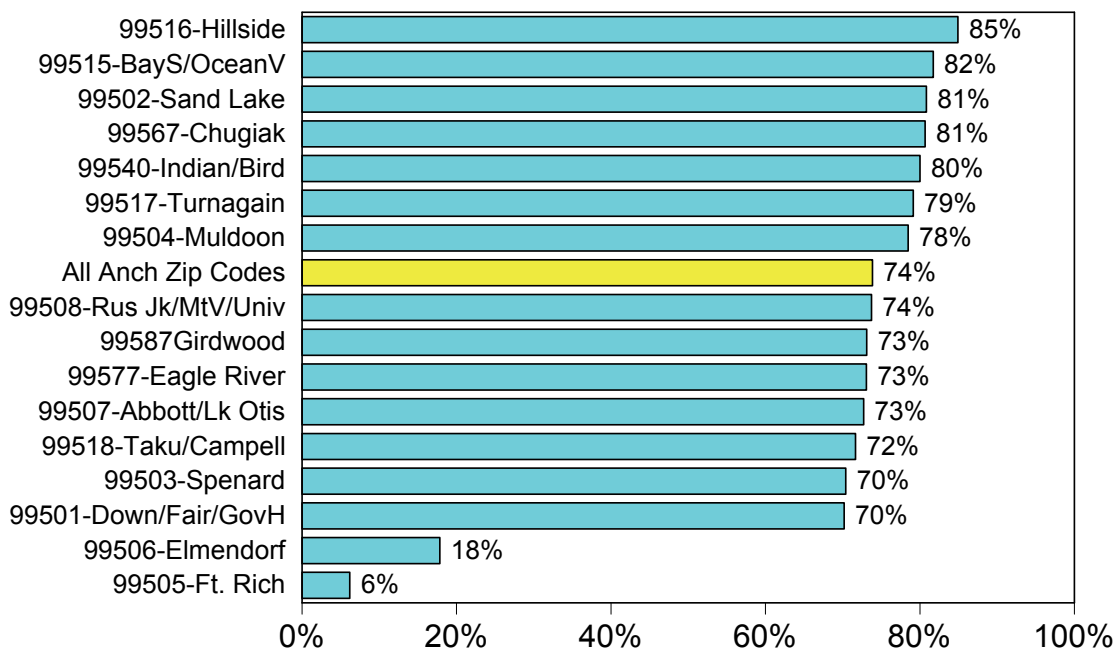
Anchorage Persons 5 Yrs. & Over by Zip Codes - 2000

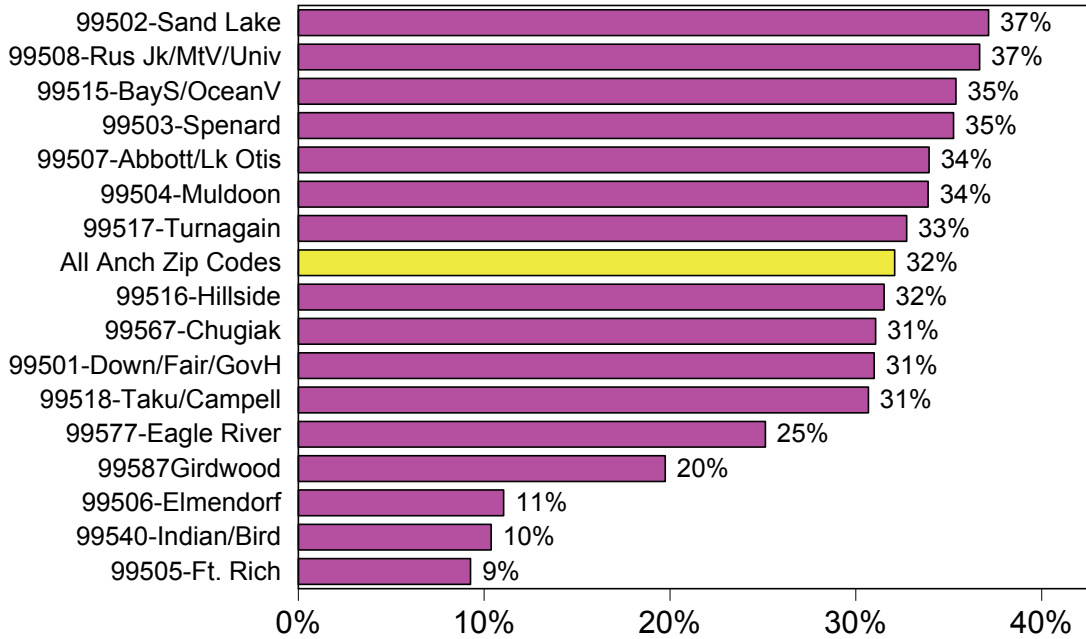

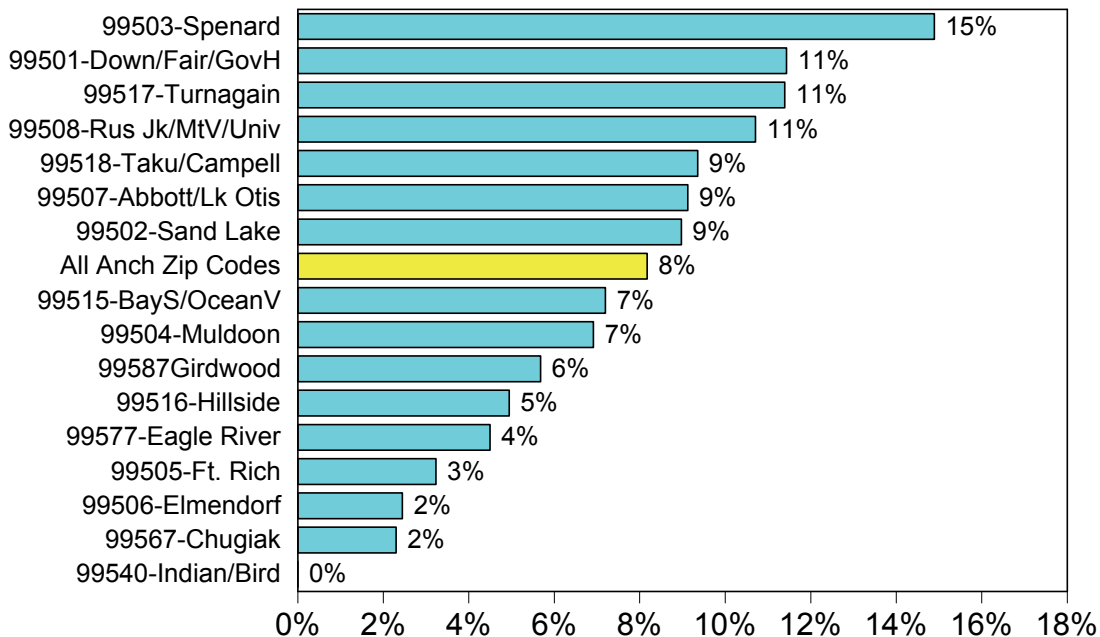
Anchorage Residents by Zip Codes - 2000

%Foreign Born

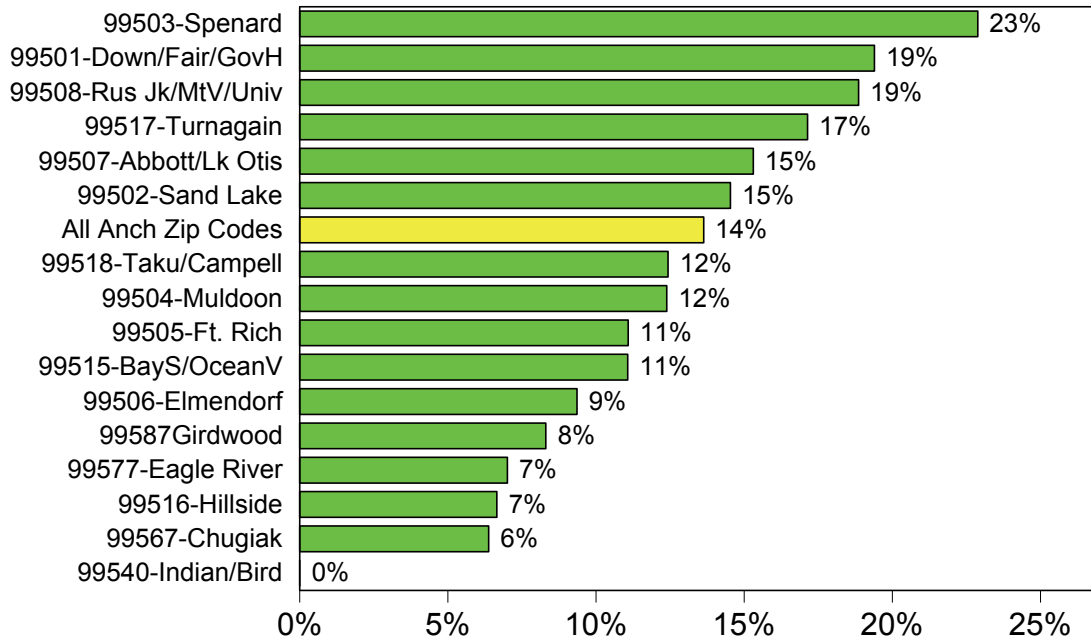
Anchorage Residents by Zip Codes - 2000

%Don't Speak English at Home

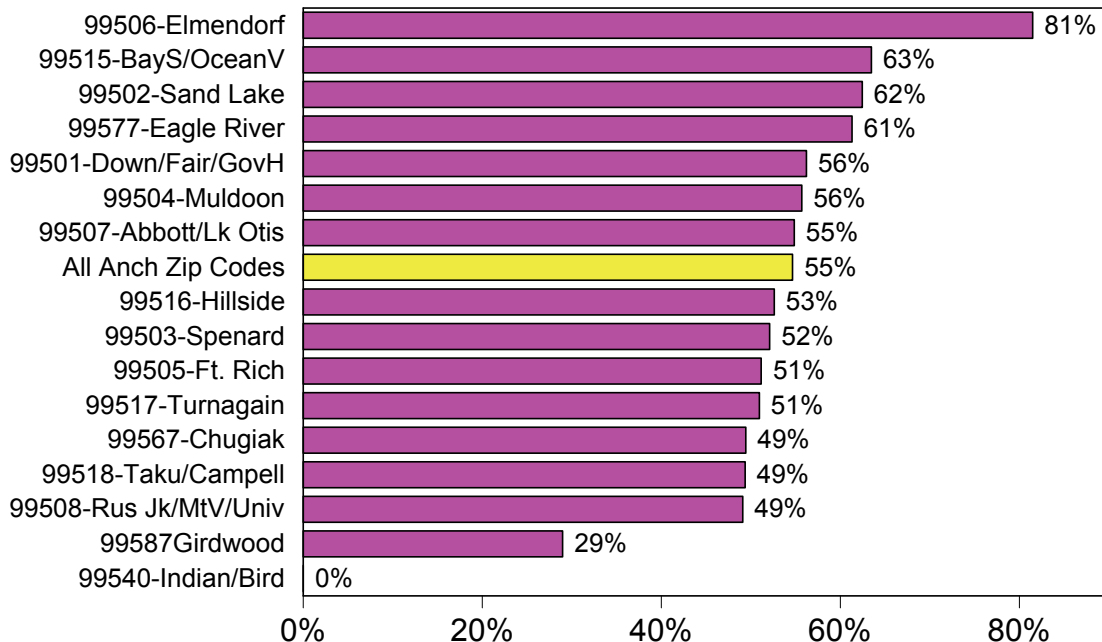
Anchorage Persons 5 Yrs. & Over by Zip Codes - 2000

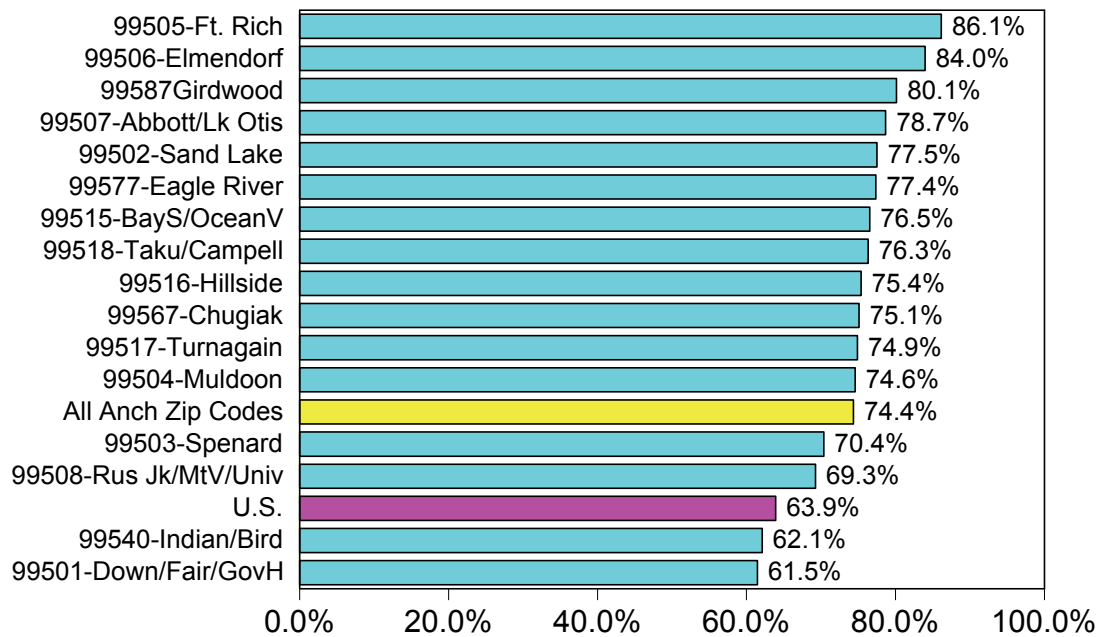

% Persons 16 & Up in Labor Force

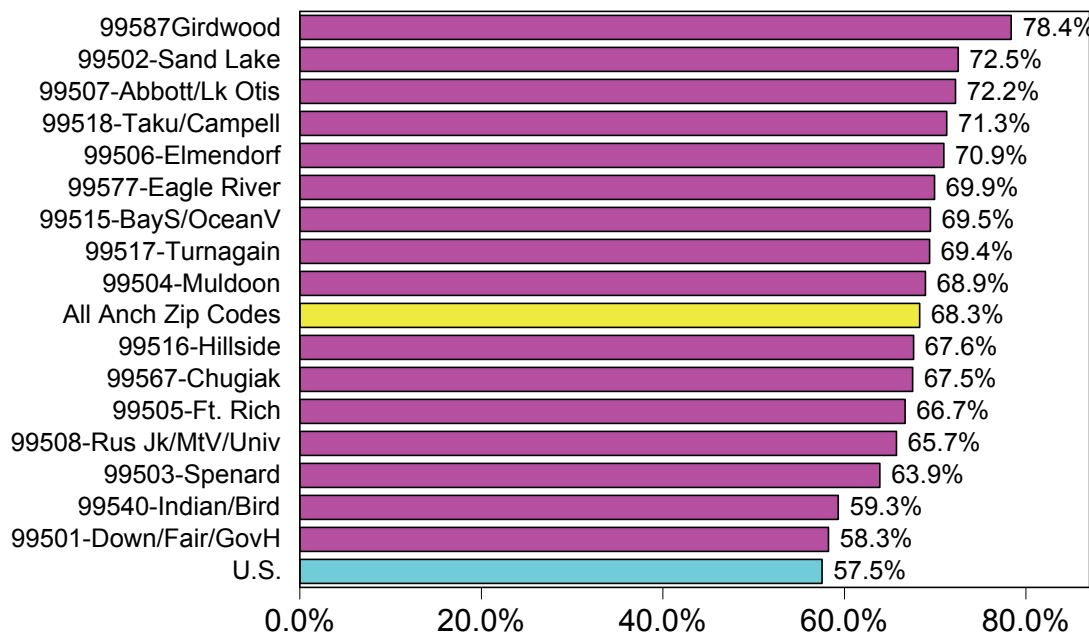

% Women 16 & Up in Labor Force

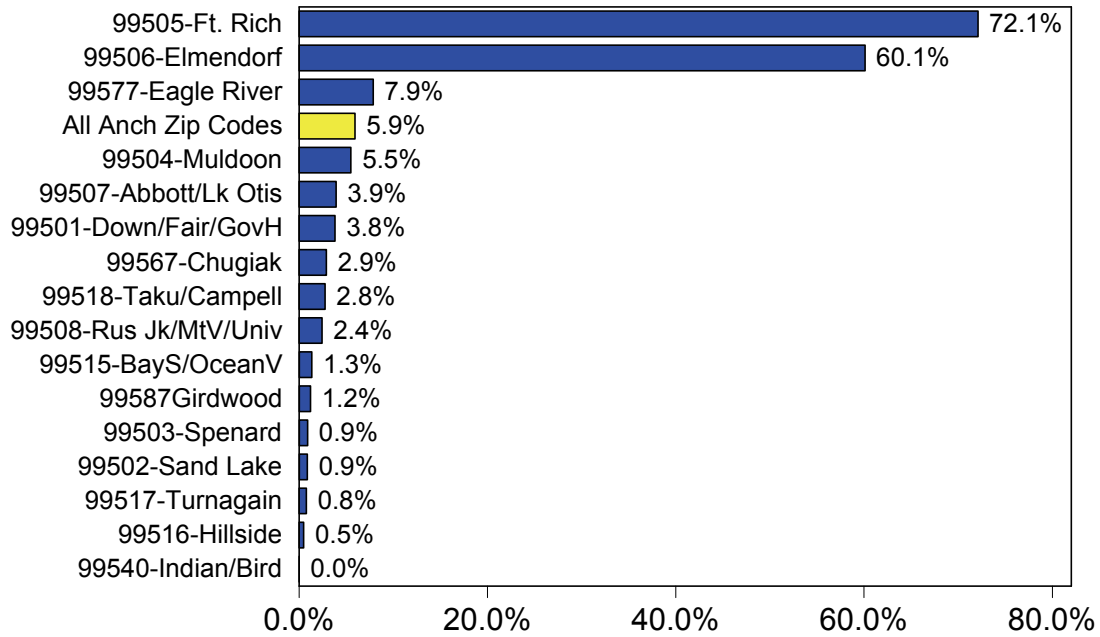

%Military in Labor Force

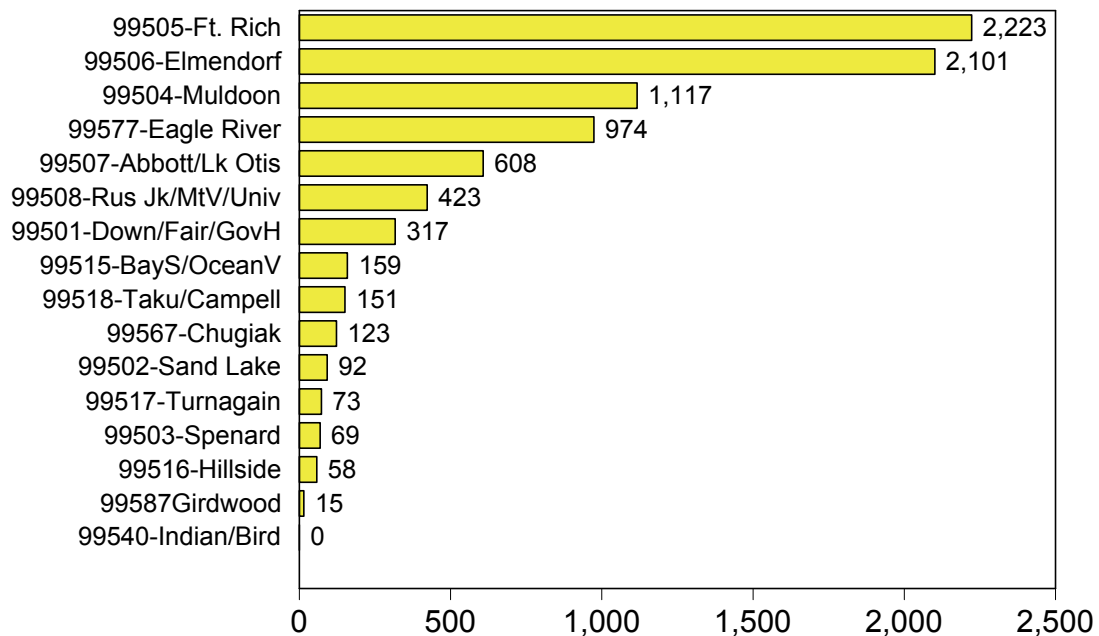

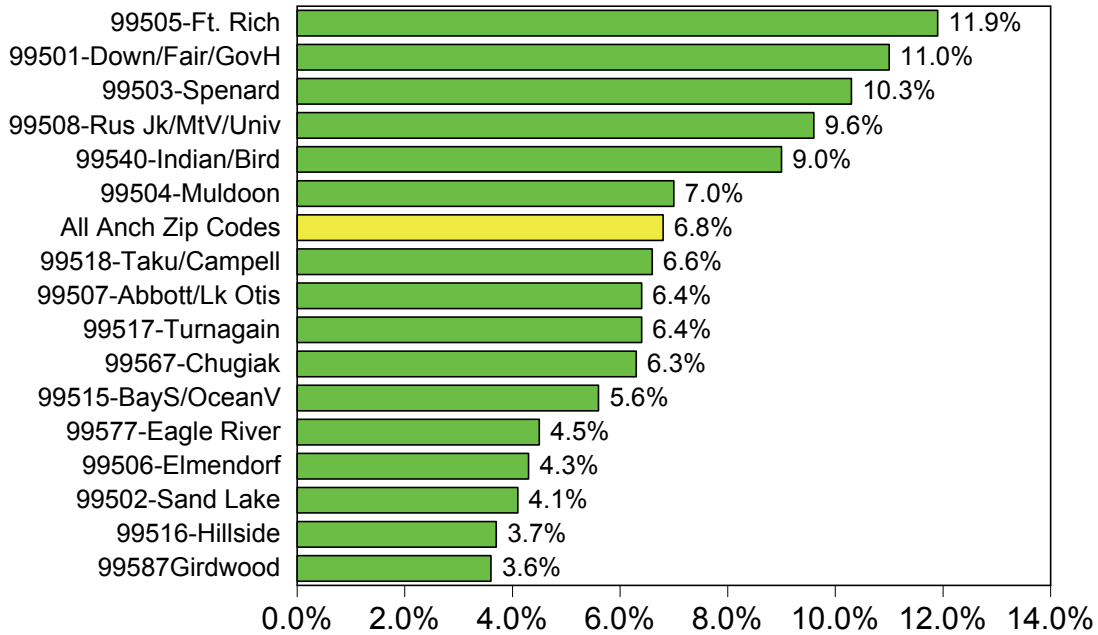

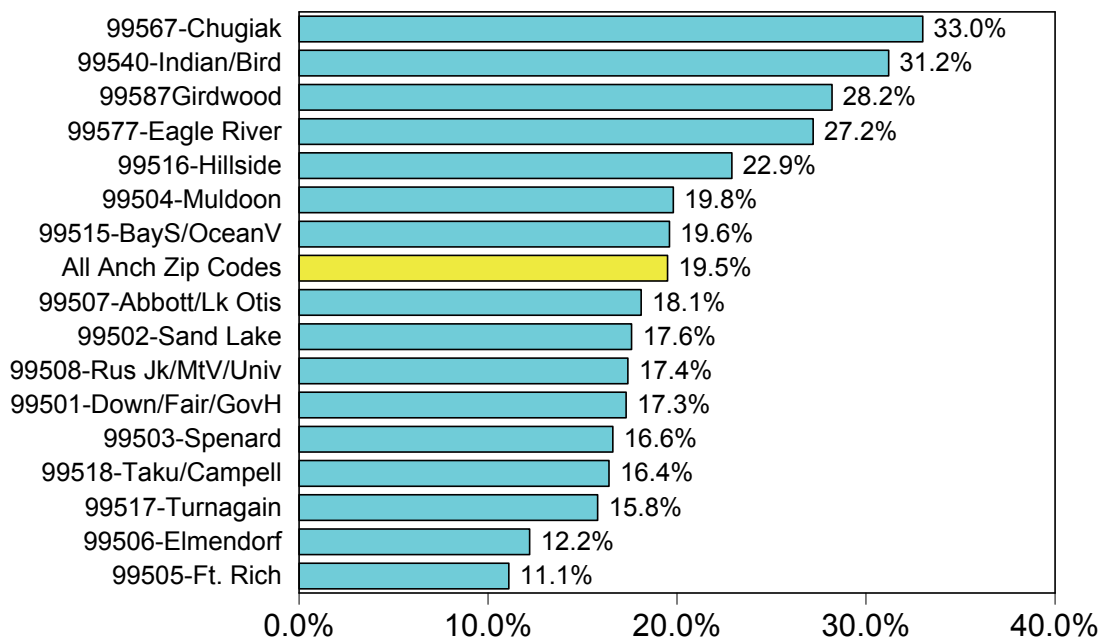

Average Travel Time to Work

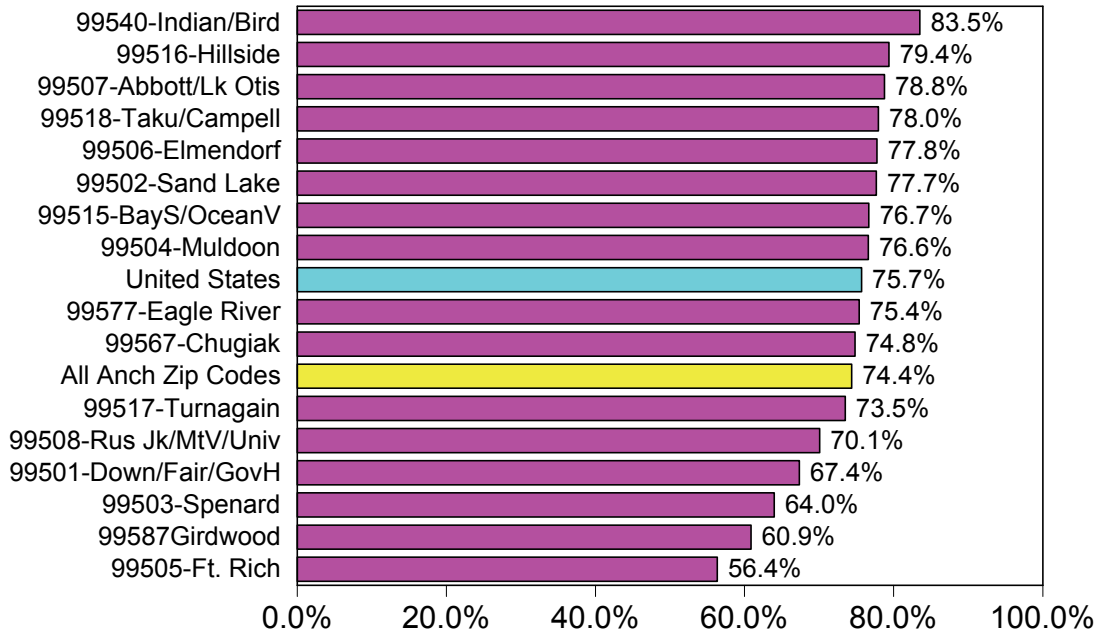

Drove Alone to Work

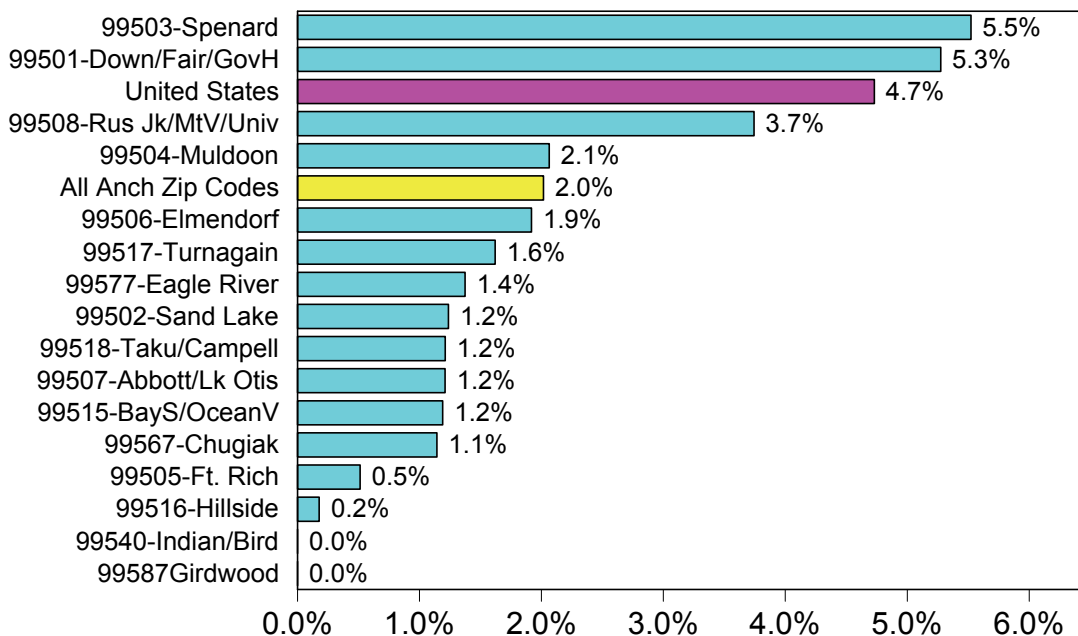
Anchorage Workers 16 Yrs. & Up by Zip Codes - 2000

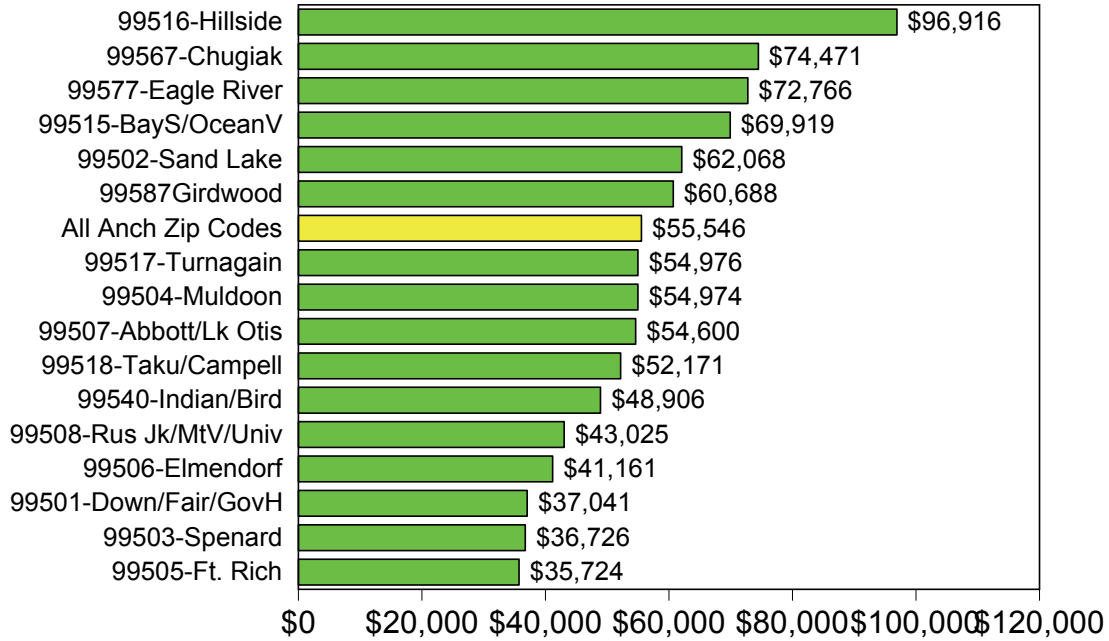
Anchorage Workers 16 Yrs. & Up by Zip Codes - 2000

Median Household Income

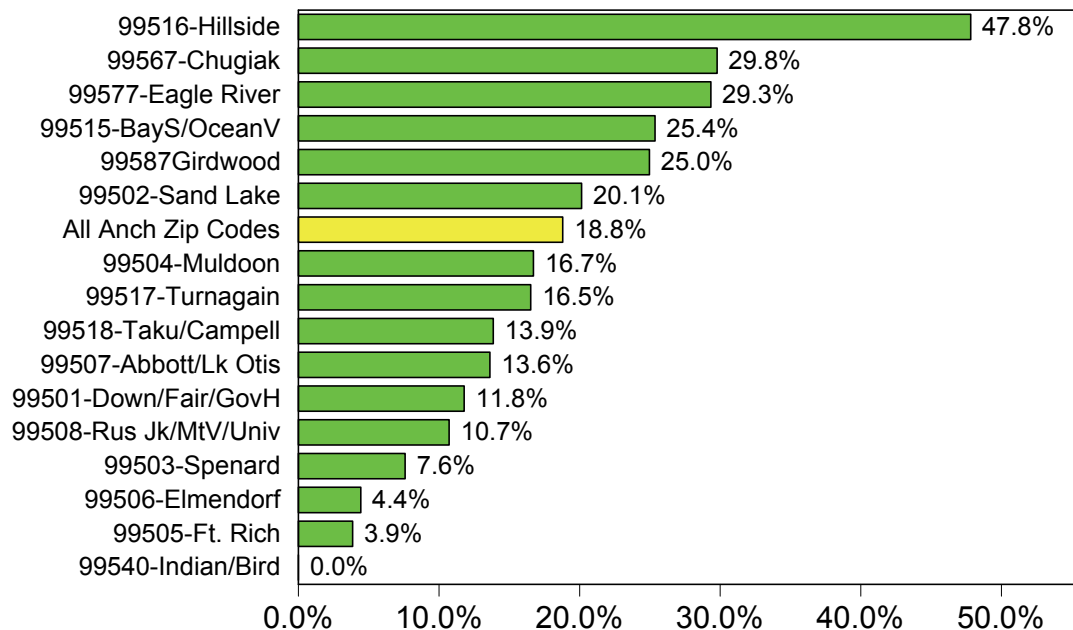

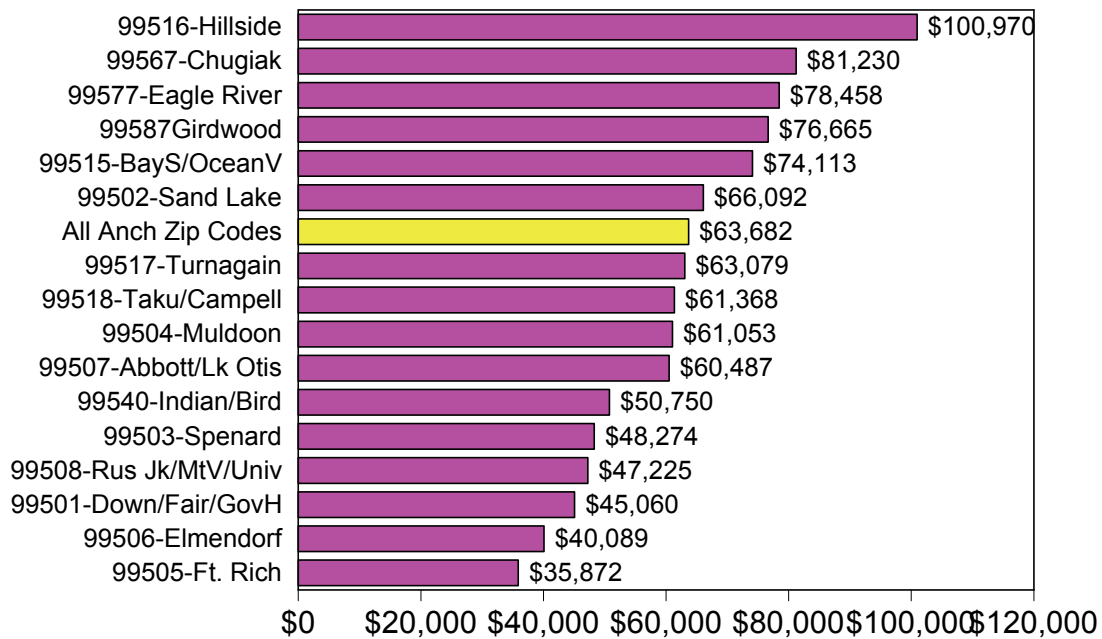

Median Family Income

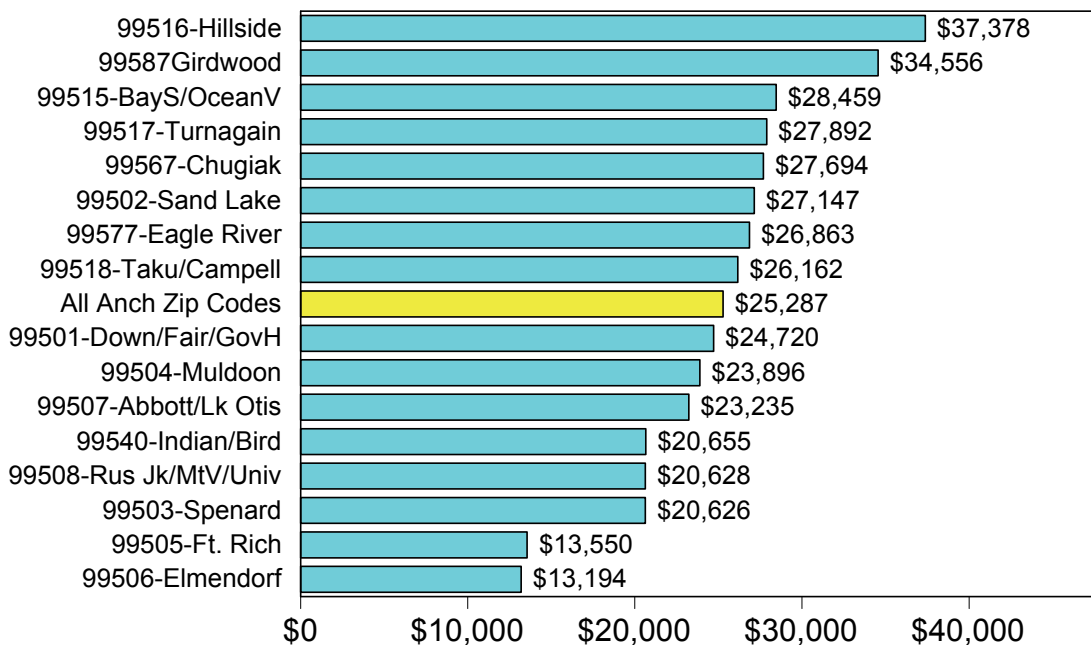
Anchorage Zip Codes - 2000

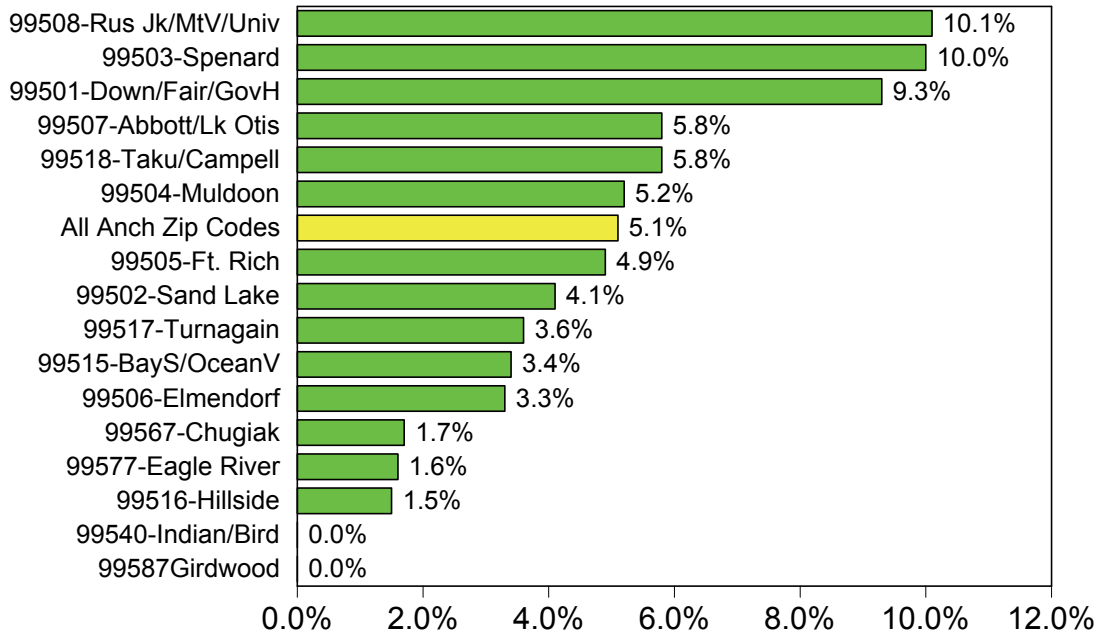

%Families Below Poverty Level

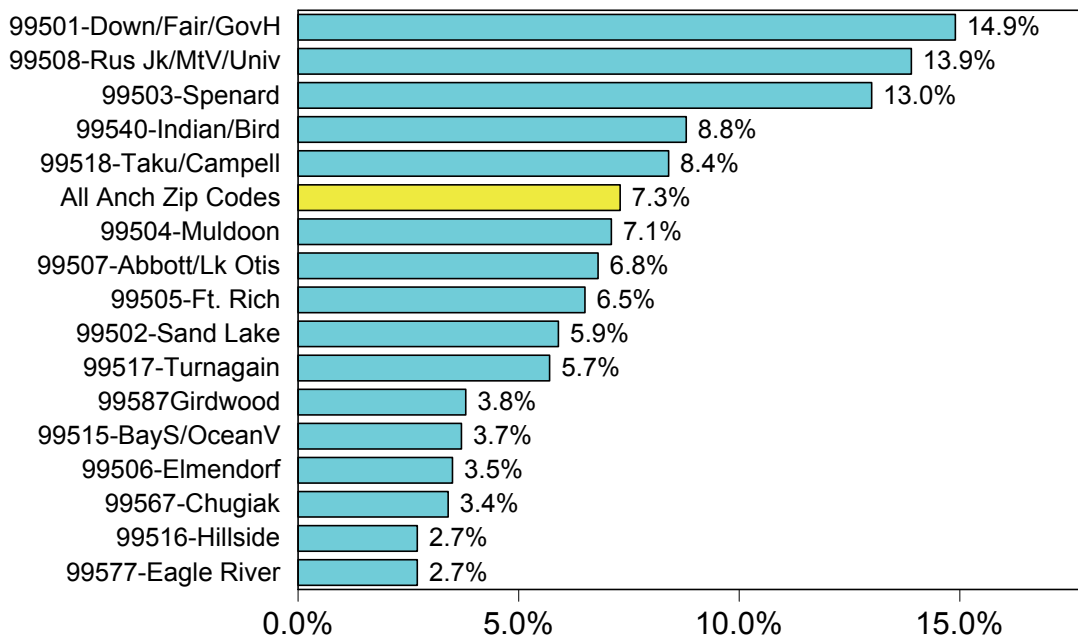
Anchorage Zip Codes- 2000

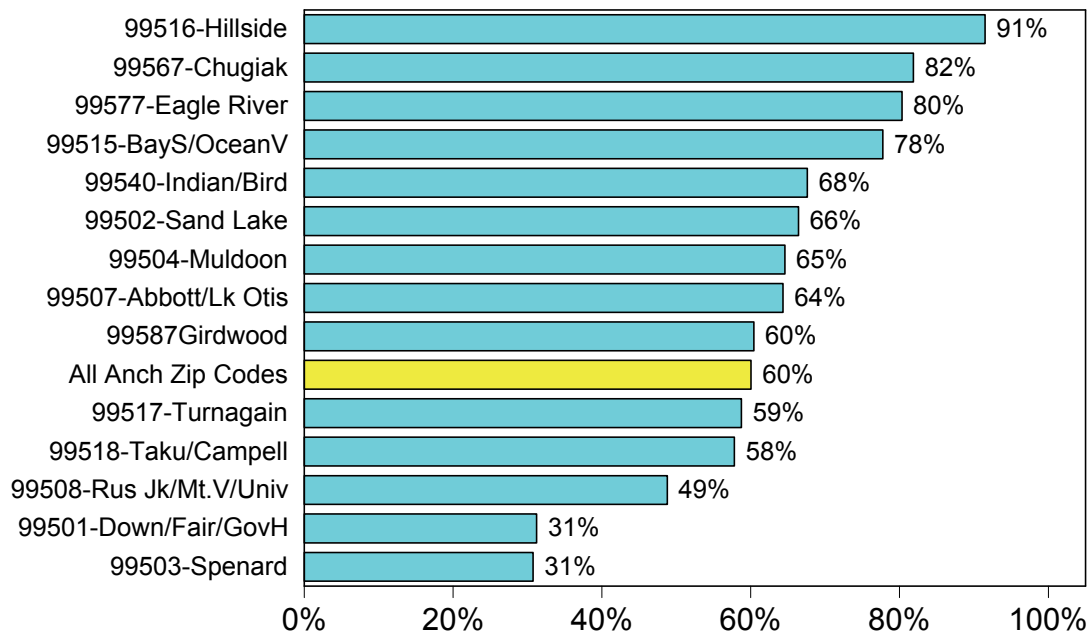

% Home Ownership

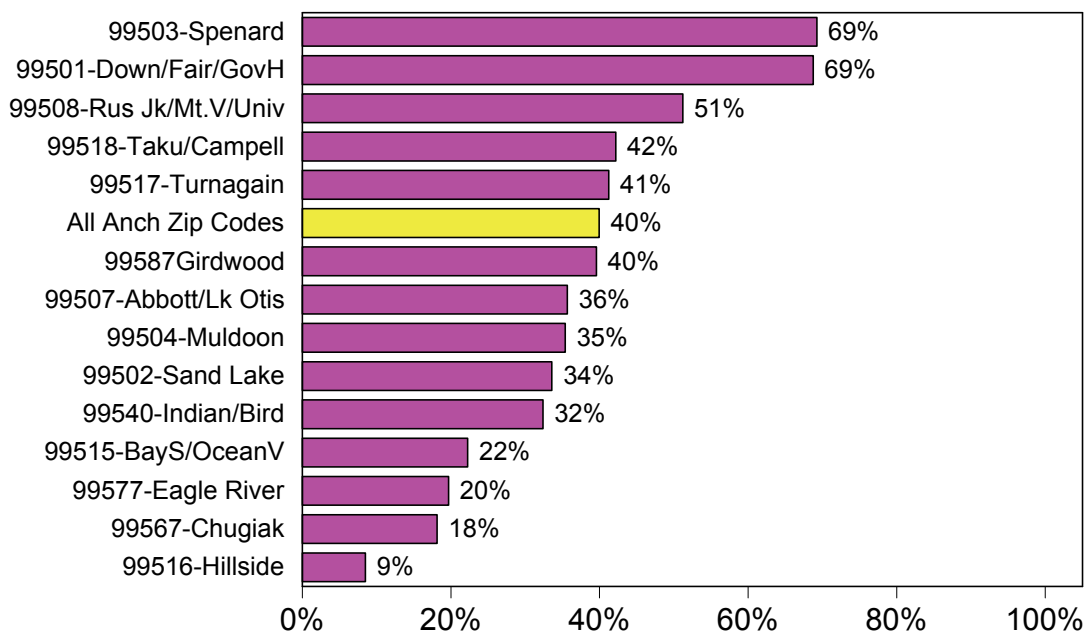

% Renter Households

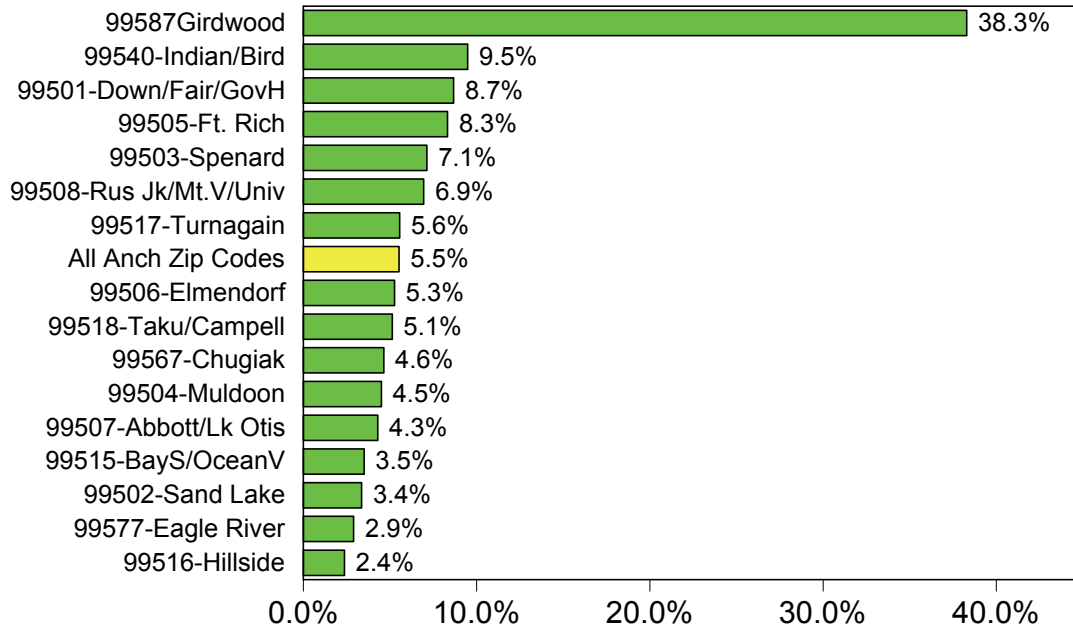

% Vacant Units

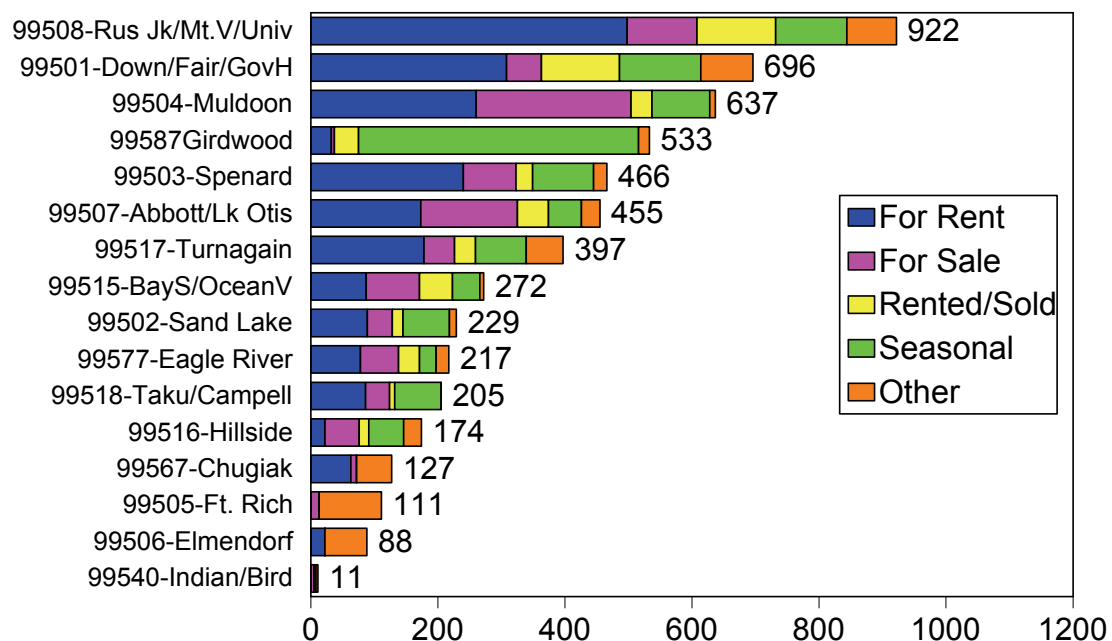

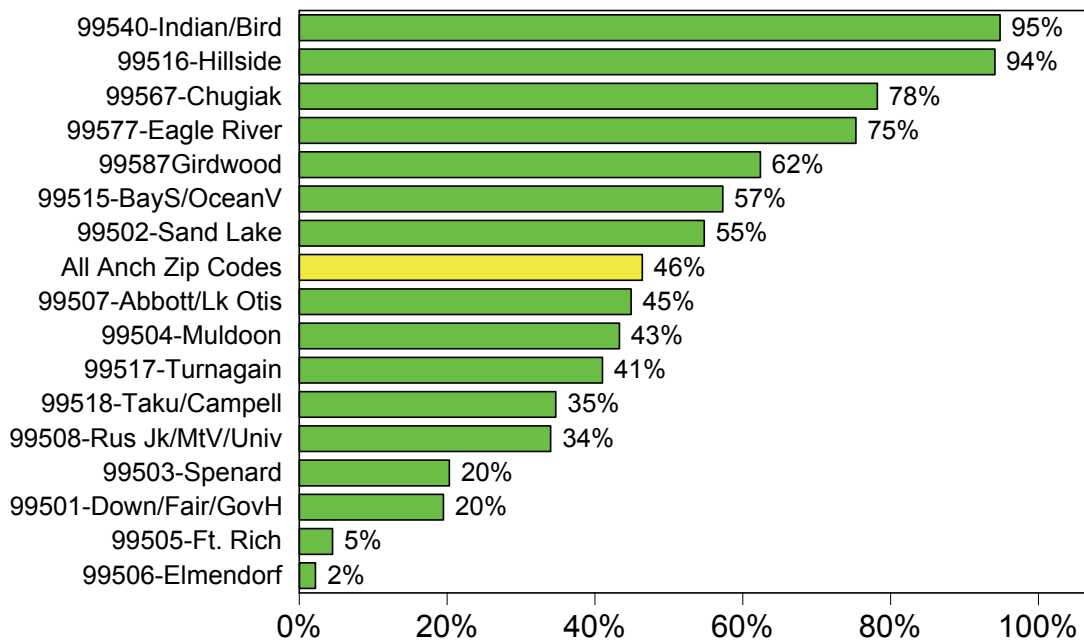

% Single Family Detached Homes

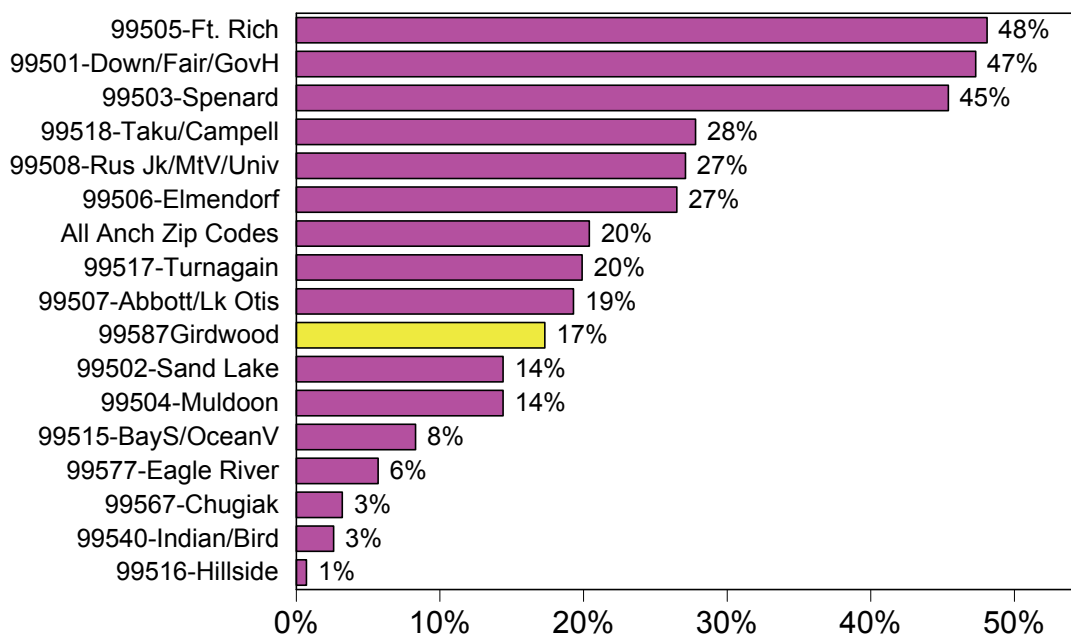

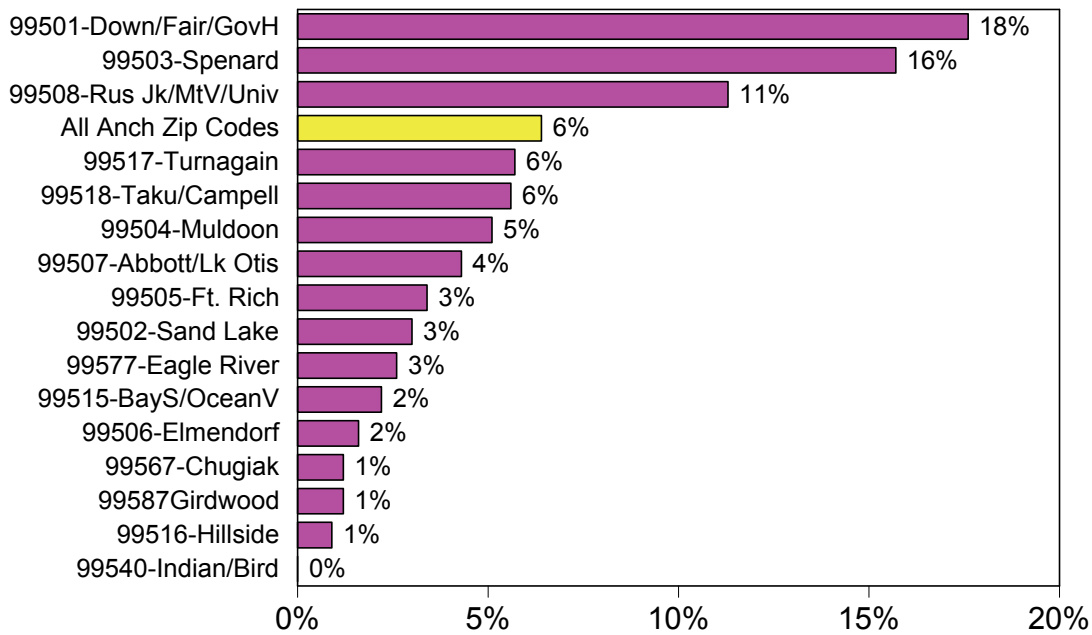

% Households with No Vehicle

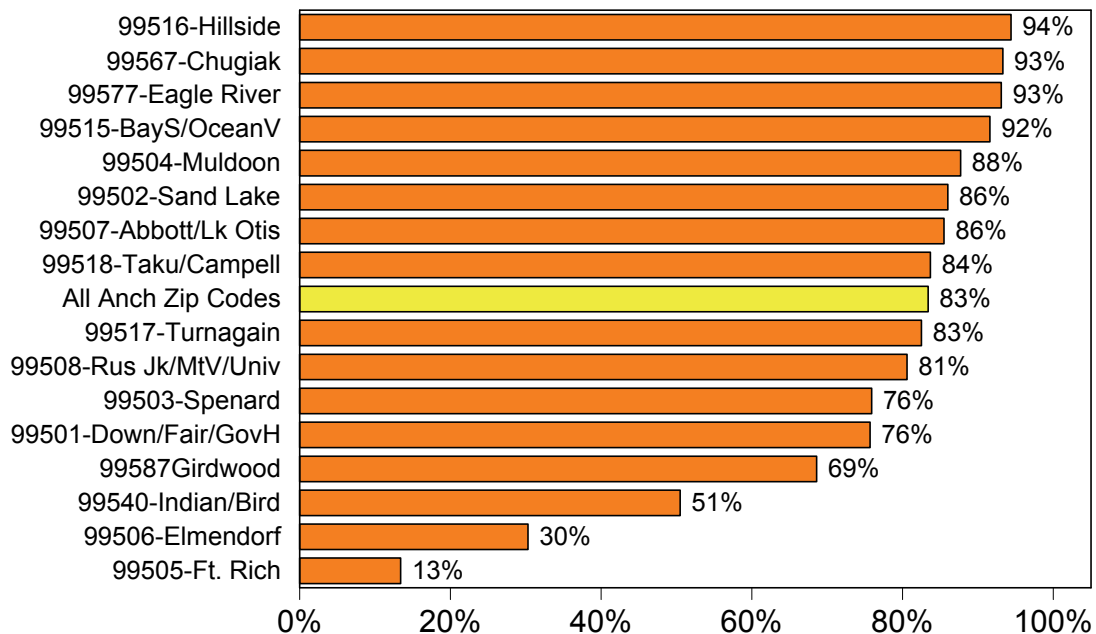

% Homes Heated with Utility Gas

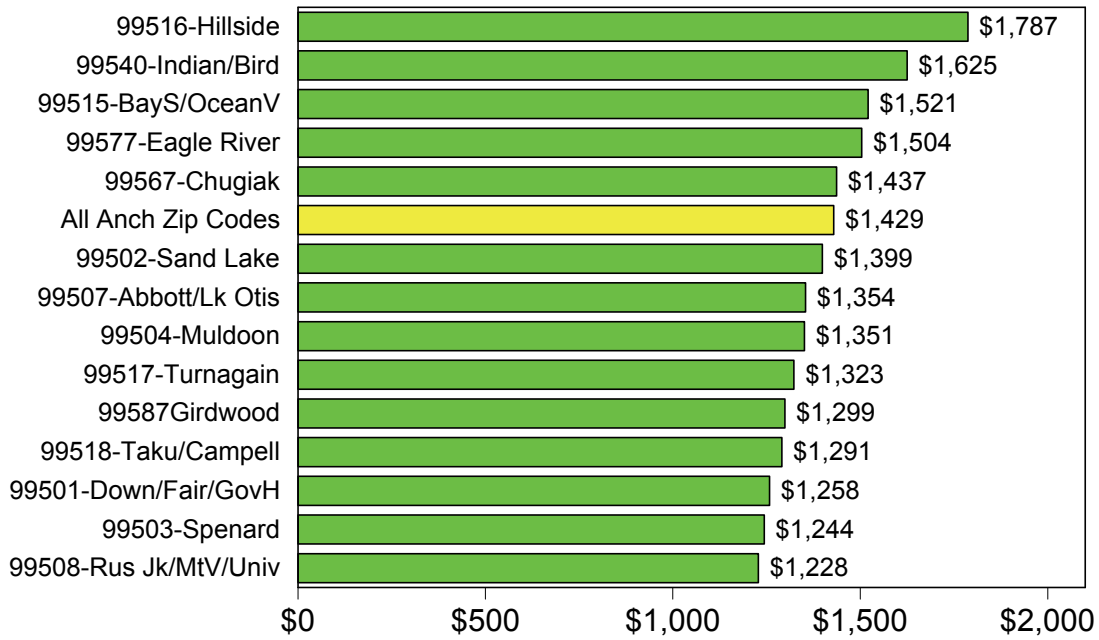

Median Mortgage Payments

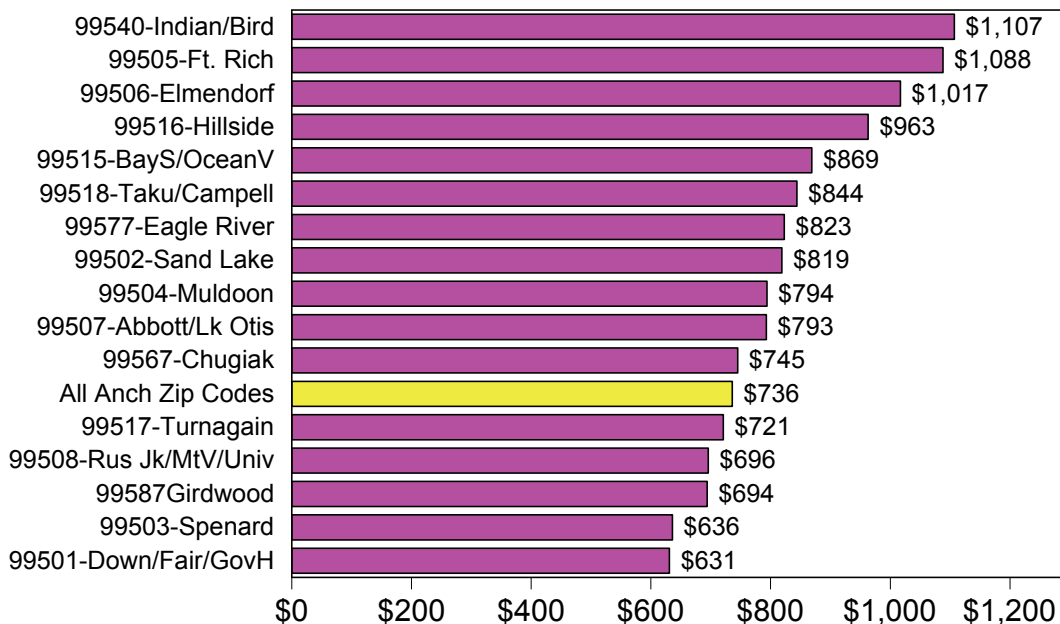
Owner Occupied by Anchorage Zip Codes - 2000

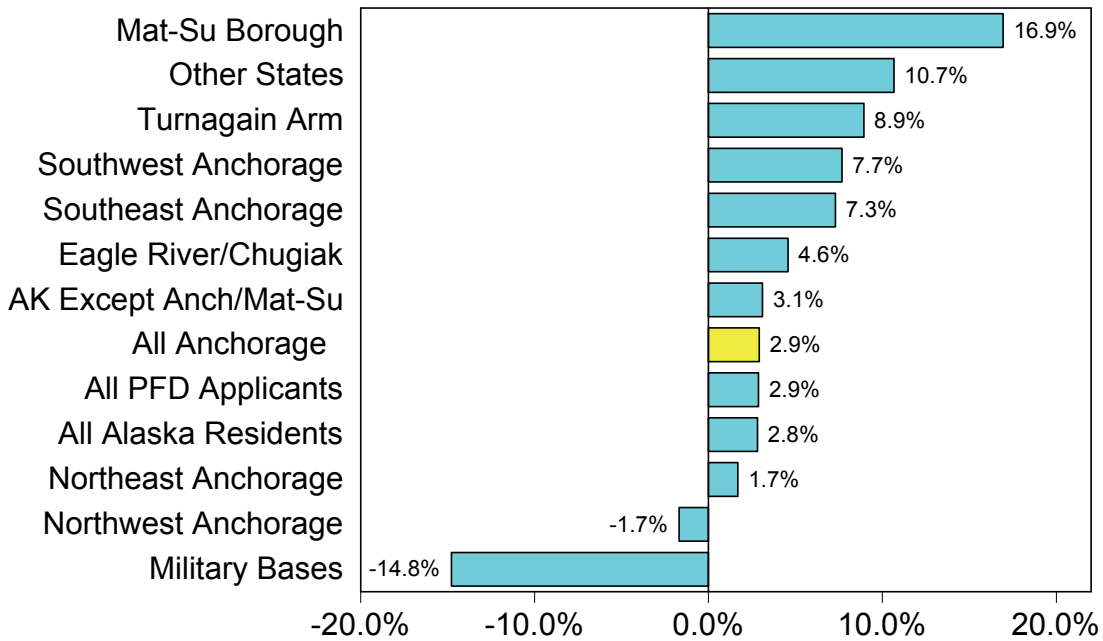

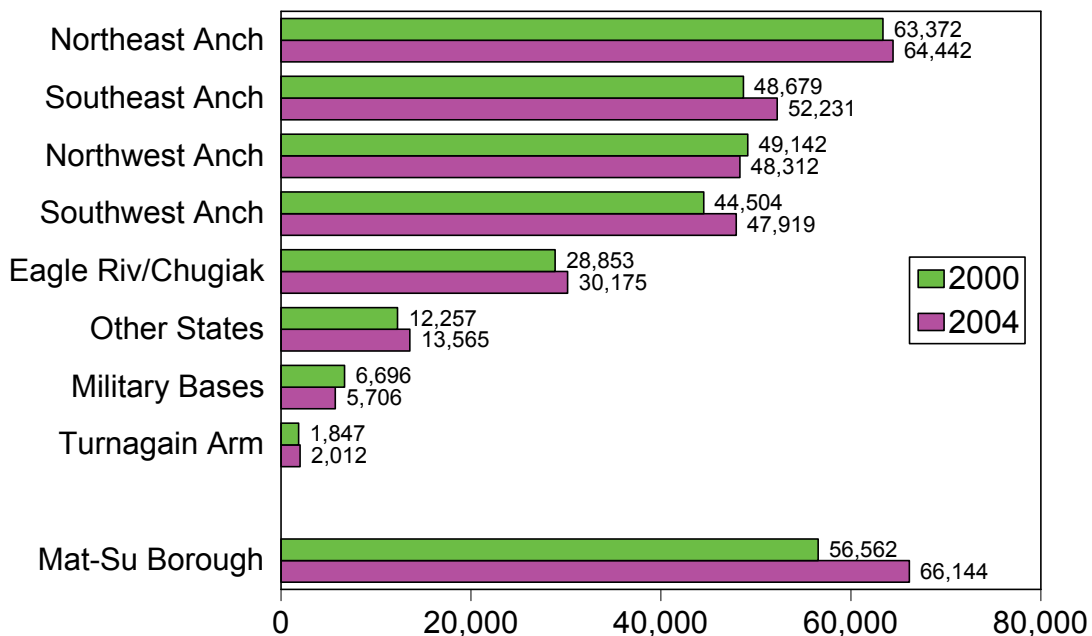
Anchorage & Mat-Su Between 2000 & 2004

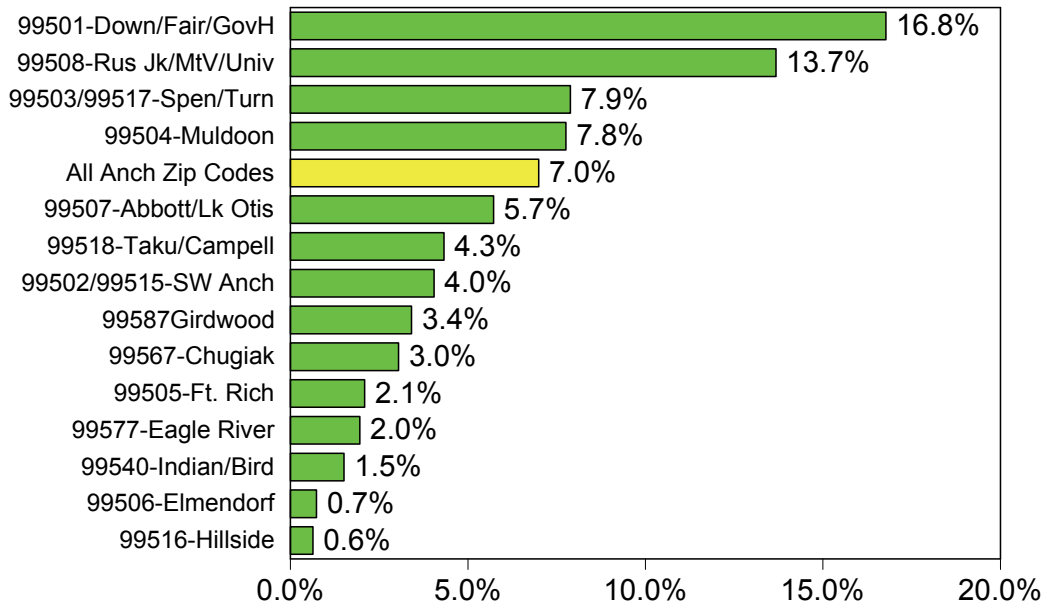
Anchorage Areas & Mat-Su 2000 & 2004
